God of the Resurrection

Acts 13 ... message of Paul

29 And when they had fulfilled all that was written of him, they took him down from the tree, and laid him in a sepulchre.

30 But God raised him from the dead:

- **31** And he was seen many days of them which came up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are his witnesses unto the people.
- **32** And we declare unto you glad tidings, how that the promise which was made unto the fathers.
- 33 God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.
- **34** And as concerning that **he raised him up from the dead**, now no more to return to corruption, he said on this wise, **I will give you the sure mercies of David.**

Psalm 2

7 I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my **Son**; this **day** have I **begotten** thee.

Hebrews 1:5

For unto which of the angels said he at any time, Thou art my **Son**, this **day** have I **begotten** thee? And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a **Son**?

35 Wherefore he saith also in another psalm, Thou shalt not suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

Psalm 16

10 For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine **Holy One** to see corruption.

Isaiah 1:4

Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the **Holy**One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.

Isaiah 5:19

That say, Let him make speed, and hasten his work, that we may see it: and let the **counsel of the Holy One of Israel** draw nigh and come, that we may know it!

Isaiah 5:24

Therefore as the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, so their root shall be as rottenness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: because they have cast away the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 6:3

And one cried unto another, and said, **Holy**, **holy**, **holy**, is the **LORD of hosts**: the whole **earth is full of his glory**.

Isaiah 10:17

And the light of Israel shall be for a fire, and his **Holy One for a flame**: and it shall burn and devour his thorns and his briers in one day;

Isaiah 10:20

And it shall come to pass in that day, that the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the LORD, the **Holy One of Israel, in truth**.

Acts 13 ...message of Paul (cont)

Isaiah 12:6

Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of Zion: for **great is the Holy One of Israel** in the midst of thee.

Isaiah 17:7

At that day shall a man look to his **Maker**, and his eyes shall have respect to the **Holy One** of Israel.

Isaiah 29:19

The meek also shall increase their joy in the LORD, and the poor among men shall **rejoice in the Holy One of Israel**.

Isaiah 29:23

But when he seeth his children, the work of mine hands, in the midst of him, they shall sanctify my name, and **sanctify the Holy One** of Jacob, and shall fear the God of Israel.

Isaiah 30:11

Get you out of the way, turn aside out of the path, cause the **Holy One** of Israel to cease from before us.

Isaiah 30:12

Wherefore thus saith the **Holy One** of Israel, Because ye despise this word, and trust in oppression and perverseness, and stay thereon:

Isaiah 30:15

For thus saith the **Lord GOD**, **the Holy One of Israel**; In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not.

Isaiah 30:29

Ye shall have a song, as in the night when a **holy** solemnity is kept; and gladness of heart, as when **one** goeth with a pipe to come into the mountain of the **LORD**, to the mighty One of Israel.

Isaiah 31:1

Woe to them that go down to Egypt for help; and stay on horses, and trust in chariots, because they are many; and in horsemen, because they are very strong; but they look not unto the **Holy One of Israel**, neither seek the LORD!

Isaiah 37:23

Whom hast thou reproached and blasphemed? and against whom hast thou exalted thy voice, and lifted up thine eyes on high? even against the Holy One of Israel.

Acts 13 ...message of Paul (cont)

Isaiah 40:25

To whom then will ye liken me, or shall I be equal? saith the Holy One.

Isaiah 41:14

Fear not, thou worm Jacob, and ye men of Israel; I will help thee, saith the LORD, and thy **redeemer**, the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 43:14

Thus saith the LORD, your **redeemer**, **the Holy One of Israel**; For your sake I have sent to Babylon, and have brought down all their nobles, and the Chaldeans, whose cry is in the ships.

Isaiah 48:17

Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the **Holy One** of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.

Isaiah 41:16

Thou shalt fan them, and the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them: and thou shalt rejoice in the LORD, and shalt **glory in the Holy One of Israel.**

Isaiah 41:20

That they may see, and know, and consider, and understand together, that the hand of the LORD hath done this, and the **Holy One** of Israel hath created it.

Isaiah 43:3

For I am the LORD thy God, the **Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour**: I gave Egypt for thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.

I am the LORD, your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King.

Isaiah 45:11

Thus saith the LORD, the **Holy One** of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me.

As for our redeemer, the LORD of hosts is his name, the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 49:7

Acts 13 ... message of Paul (cont)

Isaiah 54:5

For thy Maker is thine husband; the LORD of hosts is his name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called.

Isaiah 55:5

Behold, thou shalt call a nation that thou knowest not, and nations that knew not thee shall run unto thee because of the LORD thy God, and for the **Holy One** of Israel; for he hath glorified thee.

Isaiah 57:15

For thus saith the **high and lofty One** that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is **Holy**; I dwell in the high and **holy** place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite **one**s.

Isaiah 60:9

Surely the isles shall wait for me, and the ships of Tarshish first, to bring thy sons from far, their silver and their gold with them, unto the name of the LORD thy God, and to the **Holy One** of Israel, because he hath glorified thee.

Isaiah 60:14

The sons also of them that afflicted thee shall come bending unto thee; and all they that despised thee shall bow themselves down at the soles of thy feet; and they shall call thee; **The city of the LORD, The Zion of the Holy One of Israel**.

Acts 13 ...message of Paul (cont)

- **36** For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell on sleep, and was laid unto his fathers, and **saw corruption**:
- 37 But he, whom God raised again, saw no corruption.
- **38** Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins:
- **39** And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.
- **40** Beware therefore, lest that come upon you, which is spoken of in the prophets;

God of the Resurrection (cont)

Romans 4 ...the promise

- **13** For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but **through the righteousness of faith**.
- **14** For if they which are of the law be heirs, faith is made void, and the promise made of none effect:
- **15** Because the law worketh wrath: for where no law is, there is no transgression.
- 16 Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,
- **17** (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even **God**, **who quickeneth the dead**, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.
- **18** Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.
- **19** And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb:

Justification of the Resurrection

Romans 4 (cont) ... of Abraham

- 20 He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;
- 21 And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.
- 22 And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness.
- 23 Now it was **not written for his sake alone**, that it was imputed to him;
- 24 But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead:
- **25** Who was **delivered for our offences**, and was **raised again for our <u>justification</u>**. <u>Justification</u> NT:1347 >dikai/wsi\$ > dikaiosis (dik-ah'-yo-sis); from NT:1344; acquittal (for Christ's sake): KJV justification.

Acquittal – Discharge, exoneration, freeing, liberty from all charges...

...once conviction by the law...made free by grace of God...

The Work of the Resurrection

Ephesians 1

- **18** The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,
- **19** And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,
- 20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,

Psalm 110

- 1 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.
- **21** Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and **every name that is named,** not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

Galatians 1

1 Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;)

Death of Jesus for Resurrection

1 Thessalonians 5

- 9 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 10 Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him.
- 11 Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.

Romans 5

- **7** For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die.
- 8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, **Christ died** for us.
- **9** Much more then, being now justified by his blood, **we shall be saved** from wrath through him.

Baptism of the Resurrection

Romans 6

- **3** Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?
- 4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- 5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:

Colossians 2

- **11** In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:
- 12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.
- **13** And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he **quickened together with him**, having forgiven you all trespasses;

Finality of the Resurrection

Matthew 26

- **63** But Jesus held his peace, And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.
- **64** Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- **65** Then the high priest rent his clothes, saying, He hath spoken blasphemy; what further need have we of witnesses? behold, now ye have heard his blasphemy.

Romans 6

9 Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.

Romans 5

- **9** Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.
- **10** For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.
- **11** And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.

Hebrews 7

- **26** For such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens;
- **27** Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself.

1 Corinthians 15

54 ... Death is swallowed up in victory.

Glorification of the Resurrection

Romans 8

- **10** And if Christ be in you, the **body is dead** because of sin; but the **Spirit is life** because of righteousness.
- 11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.
- 12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.
- **28** And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.
- **29** For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- **30** Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he **called**, them he also **justified**: and whom he justified, **them he also glorified**.
- 31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?
- 32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?
- 33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.
- **34** Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh <u>intercession</u> for us.

<u>Intercession</u> – NT:1793 >e)ntugxa/nw > entugchano (en-toong-khan'-o); from NT:1722 and NT:5177; to chance upon, i.e. (by implication) confer with; by extension to entreat (in favor or against): KJV - deal with, make intercession.

...from – NT:1722 >e)n > en (en); a primary preposition denoting (fixed) position (in place, time or state), and (by implication) instrumentality (medially or constructively), i.e. a relation of rest (intermediate between NT:1519 and NT:1537); "in," at, (up-) on, by, etc.:

KJV - about, after, against, almost, altogether, among, as, at, before, between, (here-) by (+all means), for (... sake of), giveself wholly to, (here-) in (-to, -wardly), mightily, (because) of, (up-) on, [openly-], outwardly, one, quickly, shortly, [speedily-], that, there (-in, -on), through (-out), (un-) to (-ward), under, when, where (-with), while, with (-in). Often used in compounds, with substantially the same import; rarely with verbs of motion, and then not to indicate direction, except (elliptically) by a separate (and different) preposition.

...from – NT:5177 >tugxa/nw > tugchano (toong-khan'-o); probably for an obsolete tucho (for which the middle voice of another alternate teucho [to **make ready or bring to pass**] is used in certain tenses; akin to the base of NT:5088 through the idea of effecting; properly, to affect; or (specifically) to hit or light upon (as a mark to be reached), i.e. (transitively) to attain or secure an object or end, or (intransitively) to happen (as if meeting with); but in the latter application only impersonal (with NT:1487), i.e. perchance; or (present participle) as adjective, usual (as if commonly met with, with NT:3756, extraordinary), neuter (as adverb) perhaps; or (with another verb) as adverb, by accident (as it were):

KJV - be, chance, enjoy, little, obtain, refresh ...self, special. Compare NT:5180.

Glorification of the Resurrection (cont)

Romans 8

- **35** Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
- **36** As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.
- **37** Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.
- 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,
- 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

1 Corinthians 15 ...glorification of the body

- **36** Thou fool, that which thou sowest is not quickened, except it die:
- **37** And that which thou sowest, thou sowest not that body that shall be, but bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or of some other grain:
- **38** But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body.
- **39** All flesh is not the same flesh: but there is one kind of flesh of men, another flesh of beasts, another of fishes, and another of birds.
- **40** There are also celestial bodies, and bodies terrestrial: but the glory of the celestial is one, and the glory of the terrestrial is another.
- **41** There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars: for one star differeth from another star in glory.
- **42** So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:
- **43** It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:
- **44** It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.
- **45** And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a **quickening spirit**.
- **46** Howbeit that was **not first which is spiritual**, but that which is natural; and **afterward that which is spiritual**.
- **47** The first man is of the earth, earthy; the **second man is the Lord from heaven**.
- **48** As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly.
- **49** And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.
- **50** Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

Matthew 22:30

For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are **as the angels of God in heaven**.

Mark 12:25

For when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage; but are as the angels which are in heaven.

Salvation of the Resurrection

Romans 10

9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

1 Corinthians 15

- **1** Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the **gospel** which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;
- **2** By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.
- 3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that **Christ died for [the sake of] our sins according to the scriptures**:

1 Corinthians 15

- 9 For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.
- **10** But **by the grace of God I am what I am**: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but **I laboured** more abundantly than they all: **yet not I**, but the grace of God which was with me.
- 11 Therefore whether it were I or they, so we preach, and so ye believed.

1 Corinthians 15

- 12 Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, how say some among you that there is no resurrection of the dead?
- 13 But if there be no resurrection of the dead, then is Christ not risen:
- 14 And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain.
- 15 Yea, and we are found false witnesses of God; because we have testified of God that he raised up Christ: whom he raised not up, if so be that the dead rise not.

16 For if the dead rise not, then is not Christ raised:

- **17** And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins.
- **18** Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished.
- 19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.

Past Present and Future Resurrection

1 Corinthians 15

- 20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.
- 21 For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead.
- 22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.
- 23 But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming.

1 Corinthians 15

- **24** Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.
- 25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.
- 26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.
- **27** For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.
- **28** And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.
- **29** Else what shall they do which are baptized for the dead, if the dead rise not at all? why are they then baptized for the dead?
- **30** And why stand we in jeopardy every hour?
- **31** I protest by your rejoicing which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily.
- **32** If after the manner of men I have fought with beasts at Ephesus, what advantageth it me, if the dead rise not? let us eat and drink; for to morrow we die.

1 Corinthians 15

- **33** Be not deceived: **evil communications corrupt good manners** [usage, moral habits].
- **34** Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame.
- **35** But some man will say, How are the dead raised up? and with what body do they come?

1 Corinthians 15

- 51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- 52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
- **53** For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.
- **54** So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.
- **55** O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?
- **56** The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.
- **57** But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- **58** Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

Galatians 1

1 Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;)

Galatians 1

- **1** Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;)
- **2** And all the brethren which are with me, unto the churches of Galatia:
- 3 Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ,
- **4** Who **gave himself for our sins**, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the **will of God** and our Father:
- **5 To whom be glory** for ever and ever. Amen.

1 Peter 1

- **20** Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,
- **21** Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.
- **22** Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:
- **23** Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.
- **24** For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:
- **25** But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.

Verification of the Resurrection

Acts 3 ... message of Peter

14 But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you; 15 And killed the **Prince of life**, whom **God hath raised from the dead**; whereof we are witnesses.

Acts 4 ... Peter continues

9 If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole:

10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of **Jesus Christ of Nazareth**, whom ye crucified, whom **God raised from the dead**, **even by him** doth this man stand here before you whole.

11 This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the Head of the corner.

1 Corinthians 15 ... message of Paul

- **4** And that **he was buried**, and that he **rose again the third day** according to the scriptures:
- **5** And that he was **seen of Cephas**, then of the twelve:
- **6** After that, he was **seen of above five hundred brethren** at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.
- **7** After that, he was **seen of James**; then of all the apostles.
- 8 And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.

Luke 7 ... message of Jesus

16 And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a **great prophet** is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.

17 And this rumour of him went forth throughout all Judaea, and throughout all the region round about.

- **18** And the disciples of John shewed him of all these things.
- **19** And John calling unto him two of his disciples sent them to Jesus, saying, **Art thou he that should come?** or look we for another?

Deuteronomy 18:15

The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;

Deuteronomy 18:18

God of the Living

Luke 20 ... Message from the bush in which dwell the Godhead

- **36** Neither can they die any more: for they are equal unto the angels; and are the children of God, being the children of the resurrection.
- 37 Now that the dead are raised, even Moses shewed at the bush, when he calleth the Lord the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.
- 38 For he is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto him.

Power in us for the Resurrection

Matthew 10

- **1** And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.
- **6** But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.
- **7** And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- **8** Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

Authority of the Resurrection

John 12 Jesus had the authority

17 The people therefore that was with him when he called Lazarus out of his grave, and **raised him from the dead**, **bare record**.

John 6

- 38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.
- **39** And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.
- **40** And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

John 6

- **43** Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, Murmur not among yourselves.
- 44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- **45** It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.

John 11

24 Martha saith unto him, I know that he [Lazarus] shall <u>rise again</u> in the resurrection at the **last day**.

<u>Rise again</u> – NT:450 >a)ni/sthmi > anistemi (an-is'-tay-mee); from NT:303 and NT:2476; to stand up (literal or figurative, transitive or intransitive):

KJV - arise, lift up, raise up (again), rise (again), stand up (-right).

25 Jesus said unto her, **I am the <u>Resurrection</u>**, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

<u>Resurrection</u> — NT:386 >a)na/stasi\$ > anastasis (an-as'-tas-is); from NT:450; a standing up again, i.e. (literally) a resurrection from death (individual, genitive case or by implication [its author]), or (figuratively) a (moral) recovery (of spiritual truth):

KJV - raised to life again, resurrection, rise from the dead, that should rise, rising again.

26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

John 5

20 For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.

21 For as the Father <u>raiseth up</u> the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will.

<u>Raiseth up</u> – NT:1453 >e)gei/rw > egeiro (eg-i'-ro); probably akin to the base of NT:58 (through the idea of collecting one's faculties); to waken (transitively or intransitively), i.e. rouse (literally, from sleep, from sitting or lying, from disease, from death; or figuratively, from obscurity, inactivity, ruins, nonexistence):

KJV - awake, lift (up), raise (again, up), rear up, (a-) rise (again, up), stand, take up.

22 For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:

John 12 ... and the Father did raise up Lazarus...

9 Much people of the Jews therefore knew that he was there: and they came not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might see Lazarus also, whom he had raised from the dead.

John 11:25 – I Am Resurrection Experiencing Now the Resurrection

Ephesians 2

- **5** Even when **we were dead in sins**, hath **quickened us together** with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)
