## John 3 – Born Again Remarks of Nicodemus

## **Curiosity**

### John 3

**1** There was a man of the <u>Pharisees</u>, named <u>Nicodemus</u>, a <u>ruler</u> of the <u>Jews</u>: <u>Pharisees</u> – <u>NT:5330</u>  $\Phi \alpha \rho \iota \sigma \alpha \hat{\iota} \circ \varsigma$  **Pharisaios** (far-is-ah'-yos); of Hebrew origin [compare <u>OT:6567</u>]; a separatist, i.e. exclusively religious; a Pharisean, i.e. Jewish sectary: *KJV* - Pharisee.

<u>Nicodemus</u> – <u>NT:3530</u> Nικόδημος **Nikodemos** (nik-od'-ay-mos); from <u>NT:3534</u> and <u>NT:1218</u>; victorious among his people; Nicodemus, an Israelite:*KJV* - Nicodemus.

<u>Jews</u> – <u>NT:2453</u>'  $IOU\delta\alpha loc$  **Ioudaios** (ee-oo-dah'-yos); from <u>NT:2448</u> (in the sense of <u>NT:2455</u> as a country); Judaean, i.e. belonging to Jehudah: *KJV* - Jew (-ess), of Judaea.

### **Observation**

**2** The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, <u>Rabbi</u>, **we know** that thou art a <u>teacher</u> come from <u>God</u>: for no man [no body] can do these <u>miracles</u> that thou doest, except [unless] God be with him.

<u>Rabbi</u> – <u>NT:4461</u>  $\delta \alpha \beta \beta i$  **rhabbi** (hrab-bee'); of Hebrew origin [<u>OT:7227</u> with pronominal suffix); my master, i.e Rabbi, as an official title of honor: *KJV* - Master, Rabbi.

...from – <u>OT:7227</u> **Tab** (rab); by contracted from <u>OT:7231</u>; abundant (in quantity, size, age, number, rank, quality): **KJV** - (in) abound (-undance, -ant, -antly), captain, elder, enough, exceedingly, full, great (-ly, man, one), increase, long (enough, [time]), (do, have) many (-ifold, things, a time), ([ship-]) master, mighty, more, (too, very) much, multiply (-tude), officer, often [-times], plenteous, populous, prince, process [of time], suffice (-lent).

<u>Teacher</u> – <u>NT:1320</u>διδάσκαλος **didaskalos** (did-as'-kal-os); from <u>NT:1321</u>; an instructor (genitive case or specially): *KJV* - doctor, master, teacher.

<u>God</u> – <u>NT:2316</u> θεός **theos** (theh'-os); of uncertain affinity; a deity, especially (with <u>NT:3588</u>) the supreme Divinity; figuratively, a magistrate; by Hebraism, very: *KJV* - <sup>X</sup> exceeding, God, god [-ly, -ward].

<u>Miracles</u> – <u>NT:4592</u>  $\sigma \mu \epsilon_{10} \nu$  semeion (say-mi'-on); neuter of a presumed derivative of the base of <u>NT:4591</u>; an indication, especially ceremonially or supernaturally: *KJV* - miracle, sign, token, wonder.

### **Deuteronomy 18**

**15** The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;

**16** According to all that thou desiredst of the LORD thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not.

**17** And the LORD said unto me, They have well spoken that which they have spoken.

**18** I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.

**19** And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him.

**20** But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die.

**21** And if thou say in thine heart, How shall we know the word which the LORD hath not spoken?

**22** When a prophet speaketh in the name of the LORD, if the thing follow not, nor come to pass, that is the thing which the LORD hath not spoken, but the prophet hath spoken it presumptuously: thou shalt not be afraid of him.

## John 3 – Born Again The Reproval of Nicodemus

### Instruction

### John 3

**3** Jesus <u>answered</u> and said [spoke] unto him, <u>Verily</u>, verily, I say unto thee, Except [unless] a man [a person] be <u>born</u> again, he cannot <u>see</u> the <u>kingdom</u> of God.

<u>Answered</u> – <u>NT:611</u> άποκρίνομαι **apokrinomai** (ap-ok-ree'-nom-ahee); from <u>NT:575</u> and krino; to conclude for oneself, i.e. (by implication) to respond; by Hebraism [compare <u>OT:6030]</u> to begin to speak (where an adress is expected): *KJV* - answer.

<u>Verily</u> – <u>NT:281</u>  $\dot{\alpha}\mu\dot{\eta}\nu$  **amen** (am-ane'); of Hebrew origin [<u>OT:543</u>]; properly, firm, i.e. (figuratively) trustworthy; adverbially, surely (often as interj. so be it): *KJV* - amen, verily.

...from – <u>OT:543</u> **'amen** (aw-mane'); from <u>OT:539</u>; sure; abstract, faithfulness; adverb, truly: *KJV* - Amen, so be it, truth.

<u>Born</u> – <u>NT:1080</u> γεννάω **gennao** (ghen-nah'-o); from a variation of <u>NT:1085</u>; to procreate (properly, of the father, but by extension of the mother); figuratively, to regenerate:

**KJV** - bear, beget, be born, bring forth, conceive, be delivered of, gender, make, spring.

...from – <u>NT:1085</u>  $\gamma \epsilon \nu o \zeta$  genos (ghen'-os); from <u>NT:1096</u>; "kin" (abstract or concrete, literal or figurative, individual or collective):

**KJV** - born, country (-man), diversity, generation, kind (-red), nation, offspring, stock.

<u>See</u> – <u>NT:1492</u> εἴδω **eido** (i'-do); a primary verb; used only in certain past tenses, the others being borrowed from the equivalent <u>NT:3700</u> and <u>NT:3708</u>; properly, to see (literally or figuratively); by implication (in the perf. only) to know: **KJV** - be aware, behold, <sup>X</sup> can (+not tell), consider, (have) know (-ledge), look (on), perceive, see, be sure, tell, understand, wish, wot. Compare <u>NT:3700</u>.

<u>Kingdom</u> – <u>NT:932</u> βασιλεία **basileia** (bas-il-i'-ah); from <u>NT:935</u>; properly, royalty, i.e. (abstractly) rule, or (concretely) a realm (literally or figuratively): **KJV** - kingdom, + reign.

### **Questions**

### John 3

**4** Nicodemus saith [spoke] unto him, <u>How</u> can a man be <u>born</u> when he is <u>old</u>? can he enter the second time into his mother's <u>womb</u>, and be <u>born</u>?

<u>How</u> – <u>NT:4459</u>  $\pi \hat{\omega} \zeta$  **pos** (poce); adverb from the base of <u>NT:4226</u>; an interrogative particle of manner; in what way? (sometimes the question is indirect, how?); also as exclamation, how much!:

**KJV** - how, after (by) what manner (means), that. [Occasionally unexpressed in English].

<u>Born</u> – <u>NT:1080</u> γεννάω **gennao** (ghen-nah'-o); from a variation of <u>NT:1085</u>; to procreate (properly, of the father, but by extension of the mother); figuratively, to regenerate:

**KJV** - bear, beget, be born, bring forth, conceive, be delivered of, gender, make, spring.

<u>Old</u> – <u>NT:1088</u> γέρων **geron** (gher'-own); of uncertain affinity [compare <u>NT:1094</u>]; aged: *KJV* - old.

<u>Womb</u> – <u>NT:2836</u> KOI $\lambda$ í $\alpha$  **koilia** (koy-lee'-ah); from koilos ("hollow"); a cavity, i.e. (especially) the abdomen; by implication, the matrix; figuratively, the heart: **KJV** - belly, womb.

### **New Creature**

### John 3

**5** Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except [unless] a man be born of <u>water</u> and of the <u>Spirit</u>, he <u>cannot</u> enter into the kingdom of God.

<u>Water</u> – <u>NT:5204</u>  $\check{U}\delta\omega\rho$  **hudor** (hoo'-dore); genitive case, hudatos (hoo'-dat-os), etc.; from the base of <u>NT:5205</u>; water (as if rainy) literally or figuratively: **KJV** - water.

...from – <u>NT:5205</u>  $\delta$ ετός **huetos** (hoo-et-os'); from a primary huo (to rain); rain, especially a shower: *KJV* - rain.

<u>Spirit</u> – <u>NT:4151</u>  $\pi v \epsilon \hat{U} \mu \alpha$  **pneuma** (pnyoo'-mah); from <u>NT:4154</u>; a current of air, i.e. breath (blast) or a breeze; by analogy or figuratively, a spirit, i.e. (human) the rational soul, (by implication) vital principle, mental disposition, etc., or (superhuman) an angel, demon, or (divine) God, Christ's spirit, the Holy Spirit: *KJV* - ghost, life, spirit (-ual, -ually), mind. Compare <u>NT:5590</u>.

<u>Cannot</u> – <u>NT:1410</u>δύναμαι **dunamai** (doo'-nam-ahee); of uncertain affinity; to be able or possible:

**KJV** - be able, can (do, + -not), could, may, might, be possible, be of power.

### John 1

**12** But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

**13** Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

**14** And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

## 1 John 5

**6** This is he that came by **water and blood**, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the **Spirit is truth**.

## 1 John 5

**7** For there are **three that bear record in heaven**, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and **these three are one**.

8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one [Jesus - God].

## 2 Corinthians 5

16 Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more.
17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

**18** And **all things are of God**, who hath **reconciled us** to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath **given to us the ministry** of reconciliation;

### Galatians 6

**15** For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a **new creature**.

### **Carnal vs Spiritual**

### John 3

**6** That which is born of the <u>flesh</u> is **flesh**; and that which is **born of the Spirit** is <u>spirit</u>. <u>Flesh</u> – <u>NT:4561</u> $\sigma \alpha \beta \xi$  **sarx** (sarx); probably from the base of <u>NT:4563</u>; flesh (as stripped of the skin), i.e. (strictly) the meat of an animal (as food), or (by extension) the body (as opposed to the soul [or spirit], or as the symbol of what is external, or as the means of kindred), or (by implication) human nature (with its frailties [physically or morally] and passions), or (specifically) a human being (as such):

KJV - carnal (-ly, + -ly minded), flesh ([-ly]).

<u>Spirit</u> – <u>NT:4151</u>  $\pi v \epsilon \hat{U} \mu \alpha$  **pneuma** (pnyoo'-mah); from <u>NT:4154</u>; a current of air, i.e. breath (blast) or a breeze; by analogy or figuratively, a spirit, i.e. (human) the rational soul, (by implication) vital principle, mental disposition, etc., or (superhuman) an angel, demon, or (divine) God, Christ's spirit, the Holy Spirit: *KJV* - ghost, life, spirit (-ual, -ually), mind. Compare <u>NT:5590</u>.

## 1 Corinthians 15

**43** It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

44 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

**45** And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.

### Marvelous

### John 3

7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

<u>Marvel</u> – <u>NT:2296</u> θαυμάζω **thaumazo** (thou-mad'-zo); from <u>NT:2295</u>; by implication, to admire:

**KJV** - admire, have in admiration, marvel, wonder.

<u>Again</u> – <u>NT:509</u> άνωθεν **anothen** (an'-o-then); from <u>NT:507</u>; from above; by analogy, from the first; by implication, anew:

**KJV** - from above, again, from the beginning (very first), the top.

### Mark 12

11 This was the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?

### John 7

**15** And the Jews **marvel**led, saying, How knoweth this man letters, having never learned?

## **Determined**

### John 3

**8** The <u>wind bloweth</u> where it <u>listeth</u>, and thou <u>hearest</u> the <u>sound</u> thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: <u>so</u> is every one that is born of the Spirit. <u>Wind</u> – T:4151  $\pi v \epsilon \hat{0} \mu \alpha$  **pneuma** (pnyoo'-mah); from <u>NT:4154</u>; a current of air, i.e. breath (blast) or a breeze; by analogy or figuratively, a spirit, i.e. (human) the rational soul, (by implication) vital principle, mental disposition, etc., or (superhuman) an angel, demon, or (divine) God, Christ's spirit, the Holy Spirit: *KJV* - ghost, life, spirit (-ual, -ually), mind. Compare <u>NT:5590</u>.

<u>Bloweth</u> – <u>NT:4154</u>  $\pi v \dot{\epsilon} \omega$  **pneo** (pneh'-o); a primary word; to breathe hard, i.e. breeze: *KJV* - blow. Compare <u>NT:5594</u>.

<u>Listeth</u> – <u>NT:2309</u> $\theta \dot{\epsilon} \lambda \omega$  **thelo** (thel'-o); or **ethelo** (eth-el'-o); in certain tenses **theleo** (thel-eh'-o); and **etheleo** (eth-el-eh'-o); which are otherwise obsolete; apparently strengthened from the alternate form of <u>NT:138</u>; to determine (as an active option from subjective impulse; whereas <u>NT:1014</u> properly denotes rather a passive acquiescence in objective considerations), i.e. choose or prefer (literally or figuratively); by implication, to wish, i.e. be inclined to (sometimes adverbially, gladly); impersonally for the future tense, to be about to; by Hebraism, to delight in:

**KJV** - desire, be disposed (forward), intend, list, love, mean, please, have rather, (be) will (have, -ling, -ling [-ly]).

<u>Hearest</u> – <u>NT:191</u> ἀκούω **akouo** (ak-oo'-o); a primary verb; to hear (in various senses):

**KJV** - give (in the) audience (of), come (to the ears), ([shall]) hear (-er, -ken), be noised, be reported, understand.

<u>Sound</u> – <u>NT:5456</u>  $\phi \omega \nu \eta$  **phone** (fo-nay'); probably akin to <u>NT:5316</u> through the idea of disclosure; a tone (articulate, bestial or artificial); by implication, an address (for any purpose), saying or language: *KJV* - noise, sound, voice.

...akin to <u>NT:5316</u>  $\phi \alpha (\nu \omega \text{ phaino} (\text{fah'-ee-no}); \text{ prolongation for the base of <u>NT:5457</u>; to lighten (shine), i.e. show (transitive or intransitive, literal or figurative):$ *KJV*- appear, seem, be seen, shine, <sup>x</sup> think.

<u>So</u> – <u>NT:3779</u> οὕτω **houto** (hoo'-to); or (before a vowel) houtos (hoo'-toce); adverb from <u>NT:3778</u>; in this way (referring to what precedes or follows):

**KJV** - after that, after (in) this manner, as, even (so), for all that, like (-wise), no more, on this fashion (-wise), so (in like manner), thus, what.

## Deliverance

### John 3 *(Cont)*

**8** The wind bloweth where it **listeth**, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

<u>Listeth</u> – <u>NT:2309</u> $\theta \dot{\epsilon} \lambda \omega$  **thelo** (thel'-o); or **ethelo** (eth-el'-o); in certain tenses **theleo** (thel-eh'-o); and **etheleo** (eth-el-eh'-o); which are otherwise obsolete; apparently strengthened from the alternate form of <u>NT:138</u>; to determine (as an active option from subjective impulse; whereas <u>NT:1014</u> properly denotes rather a passive acquiescence in objective considerations), i.e. choose or prefer (literally or figuratively); by implication, to wish, i.e. be inclined to (sometimes adverbially, gladly); impersonally for the future tense, to be about to; by Hebraism, to delight in:

**KJV** - desire, be disposed (forward), intend, list, love, mean, please, have rather, (be) will (have, -ling, -ling [-ly]).

### The Governor at the helm...

### James 3

**4** Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the Governor **listeth**.

<u>Listeth</u> – <u>NT:3730</u>  $\delta\rho\mu\eta$  **horme** (hor-may'); of uncertain affinity; a violent impulse, i.e. onset: *KJV* - assault.

### Psalm 22 ... the Governor's deliverance

**28** For the kingdom is the LORD's: and he is the governor among the nations.

29 All they that be fat upon earth shall eat and worship: all they that go down to the dust shall bow before him: and none can keep alive his own soul.
30 A seed shall serve him; it shall be accounted to the Lord for a generation.
31 They shall come, and shall declare his righteousness unto a people that shall be born, that he hath done this.

### The Governor of promise...

### Galatians 4 ... of persecution

28 Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of promise.

29 But as then he that was **born after the flesh persecuted** him that was **born after the Spirit**, even so it is now.

**30** Nevertheless what saith the scripture? Cast out the bondwoman and her son: for the son of the bondwoman shall not be heir with the son of the freewoman.

## John 3 – Born Again Reprimand of Nicodemus

#### Manner of faith

### John 3

9 Nicodemus answered and said unto him, How can these things be?

<u>How</u> – <u>NT:4459</u>  $\pi \hat{\omega} \zeta$  **pos** (poce); adverb from the base of <u>NT:4226</u>; an interrogative particle of manner; in what way? (sometimes the question is indirect, how?); also as exclamation, how much!:

**KJV** - how, after (by) what manner (means), that. [Occasionally unexpressed in English].

<u>Be</u> – <u>NT:1096</u>  $\gamma$ ívoµ $\alpha$ I **ginomai** (ghin'-om-ahee); a prolongation and middle voice form of a primary verb; to cause to be ("gen"- erate), i.e. (reflexively) to become (come into being), used with great latitude (literal, figurative, intensive, etc.): **KJV** - arise, be assembled, be (-come, -fall, -haveself), be brought (to pass), (be) come (to pass), continue, be divided, draw, be ended, fall, be finished, follow, be found, be fulfilled, <sup>+</sup>God forbid, grow, happen, have, be kept, be made, be married, be ordained to be, partake, pass, be performed, be published, require, seem, be showed, <sup>x</sup> soon as it was, sound, be taken, be turned, use, wax, will, would, be wrought.

### Romans 8

6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

### **Masterful question**

John 3

**10** Jesus answered and said unto him, Art thou a <u>master</u> of Israel, and <u>knowest</u> not these things?

<u>Master</u> – <u>NT:1320</u>  $\delta_{l}\delta \dot{\alpha} \sigma \kappa \alpha \lambda \sigma \zeta$  **didaskalos** (did-as'-kal-os); from <u>NT:1321</u>; an instructor (genitive case or specially): *KJV* - doctor, master, teacher.

...from – <u>NT:1321</u>διδάσκω **didasko** (did-as'-ko); a prolonged (causative) form of a primary verb dao (to learn); to teach (in the same broad application): *KJV* - teach.

<u>Knowest</u> – <u>NT:1097</u> γινώσκω **ginosko** (ghin-oce'-ko); a prolonged form of a primary verb; to "know" (absolutely) in a great variety of applications and with many implications (as follow, with others not thus clearly expressed):

*KJV* - allow, be aware (of), feel, (have) know (-ledge), perceived, be resolved, can speak, be sure, understand.

## John 3 – Born Again Receipt of the Testimony

### Testimony

### John 3

**11** Verily, verily, I say unto thee, We speak that we do <u>know</u>, and <u>testify</u> that we have <u>seen</u>; and ye <u>receive</u> not our <u>witness</u>.

<u>Know</u> – T:1492 εἴδω **eido** (i'-do); a primary verb; used only in certain past tenses, the others being borrowed from the equivalent <u>NT:3700</u> and <u>NT:3708</u>; properly, to see (literally or figuratively); by implication (in the perf. only) to know: **KJV** - be aware, behold, <sup>X</sup> can (+not tell), consider, (have) know (-ledge), look (on), perceive, see, be sure, tell, understand, wish, wot. Compare <u>NT:3700</u>.

<u>Testify</u> – <u>NT:3140</u> μαρτυρέω **martureo** (mar-too-reh'-o); from <u>NT:3144</u>; to be witness, i.e. testify (literally or figuratively):

**KJV** - charge, give [evidence], bear record, have (obtain, of) good (honest) report, be well reported of, testify, give (have) testimony, (be, bear, give, obtain) witness.

<u>Seen</u> – <u>NT:3708</u>  $\dot{\delta}\rho \dot{\alpha}\omega$  **horao** (hor-ah'-o); properly, to stare at [compare <u>NT:3700</u>], i.e. (by implication) to discern clearly (physically or mentally); by extension, to attend to; by Hebraism, to experience; passively, to appear: *KJV* - behold, perceive, see, take heed.

<u>Receive</u> – <u>NT:2983</u>  $\lambda \alpha \mu \beta \dot{\alpha} \nu \omega$  **lambano** (lam-ban'-o); a prolonged form of a primary verb, which is use only as an alternate in certain tenses; to take (in very many applications, literally and figuratively [properly objective or active, to get hold of; whereas <u>NT:1209</u> is rather subjective or passive, to have offered to one; while <u>NT:138</u> is more violent, to seize or remove]):

**KJV** - accept, <sup>+</sup> be amazed, assay, attain, bring, <sup>X</sup> when I call, catch, come on (X unto), <sup>+</sup> forget, have, hold, obtain, receive (X after), take (away, up).

<u>Witness</u> –<u>NT:3141</u> μαρτυρία **marturia** (mar-too-ree'-ah); from <u>NT:3144</u>; evidence given (judicially or genitive case): *KJV* - record, report, testimony, witness.

## **Resistance of Nicodemus**

### Discernment

### John 3

**12** If I have told you <u>earthly things</u>, and ye <u>believe</u> not, **how shall ye believe**, if I tell you of <u>heavenly</u> things?

<u>Earthly things</u> – <u>NT:1919</u>  $\dot{\epsilon}\pi$  ( $\gamma\epsilon\iotao\varsigma$  epigeios (ep-ig'-i-os); from <u>NT:1909</u> and <u>NT:1093</u>; worldly (physically or morally): *KJV* - earthly, in earth, terrestrial.

<u>Believe</u> – <u>NT:4100</u> πιστεύω **pisteuo** (pist-yoo'-o); from <u>NT:4102</u>; to have faith (in, upon, or with respect to, a person or thing), i.e. credit; by implication, to entrust (especially one's spiritual well-being to Christ): **KJV** - believe (-r), commit (to trust), put in trust with.

**KJV** - believe (-r), commit (to trust), put in trust with.

<u>Heavenly</u> – <u>NT:2032</u> έπουράνιος **epouranios** (ep-oo-ran'-ee-os); from <u>NT:1909</u> and <u>NT:3772</u>; above the sky: **KJV** - celestial, (in) heaven (-ly), high.

### 1 Corinthians 2

12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.
13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

## **Revelation to Nicodemus**

Jesus is God...in Heaven...

### John 3

**13** And no man hath <u>ascended</u> up to <u>heaven</u>, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which **is in heaven**.

<u>Ascended</u> – <u>NT:305</u>  $dv\alpha\beta\alpha(\nu\omega \text{ anabaino } (an-ab-ah'-ee-no); from <u>NT:303</u> and the base of <u>NT:939</u>; to go up (literally or figuratively):$ 

KJV - arise, ascend (up), climb (go, grow, rise, spring) up, come (up).

<u>Heaven</u> – <u>NT:3772</u>ούρανός **ouranos** (oo-ran-os'); perhaps from the same as <u>NT:3735</u> (through the idea of elevation); the sky; by extension, heaven (as the abode of God); by implication, happiness, power, eternity; specifically, the Gospel (Christianity): *KJV* - air, heaven ([-ly]), sky.

## John 3 – Born Again Rehearsal of Nicodemus

### John 3 ... Rehearsal of Moses

**14** And as Moses lifted up the <u>serpent</u> in the <u>wilderness</u>, even so must the Son of man be <u>lifted up</u>:

<u>Serpent</u> – <u>NT:3789</u>  $\check{O}$  $\varphi$ I $\zeta$  **ophis** (of-is); probably from <u>NT:3700</u> (through the idea of sharpness of vision); a snake, figuratively (as a type of sly cunning) an artful malicious person, especially Satan: *KJV* - serpent.

<u>Wilderness</u> – <u>NT:2048</u>  $\xi \rho \eta \mu o \zeta$  **eremos** (er'-ay-mos); of uncertain affinity; lonesome, i.e. (by implication) waste (usually as a noun, <u>NT:5561</u> being implied): **KJV** - desert, desolate, solitary, wilderness.

<u>Lifted up</u> – <u>NT:5312</u>  $\dot{\upsilon}\psi\dot{\omega}$  **hupsoo** (hoop-so'-o); from <u>NT:5311</u>; to elevate (literally or figuratively): *KJV* - exalt, lift up.

### Numbers 21 ...for them of the past...

**9** And **Moses** made a **serpent** of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a **serpent** had bitten any man, when he **beheld the serpent** of brass, **he lived**.

### Hosea 6 ... for them in the future

**1** Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up.

2 After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight.

**3** Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.

**Rest of Nicodemus** 

Faith

John 3

**15** That whosoever <u>believeth</u> in him should not <u>perish</u>, but have <u>eternal</u> life.

<u>Believeth</u> – <u>NT:4100</u> πιστεύω **pisteuo** (pist-yoo'-o); from <u>NT:4102</u>; to have faith (in, upon, or with respect to, a person or thing), i.e. credit; by implication, to entrust (especially one's spiritual well-being to Christ):

**KJV** - believe (-r), commit (to trust), put in trust with.

<u>Eternal</u> – <u>NT:166</u> αἰώνιος **aionios** (ahee-o'-nee-os); from <u>NT:165</u>; perpetual (also used of past time, or past and future as well): *KJV* - eternal, for ever, everlasting, world (began).

...from –  $\underline{NT:165}\alpha\dot{l}\omega\nu$  **aion** (ahee-ohn'); from the same as  $\underline{NT:104}$ ; properly, an age; by extension, perpetuity (also past); by implication, the world; specially (Jewish) a Messianic period (present or future): **KJV** - age, course, eternal, (for) ever (-more), [n-] ever, (beginning of the while the) world (began, without end). Compare  $\underline{NT:5550}$ .

### **Indictment of Unbelievers**

### John 5

**36** But **I have greater witness** than that of John: for **the works** which the Father hath given me to finish, the **same works** that **I do**, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.

**37** And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. **Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape**.

**38** And ye **have not his word abiding in you**: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not. **39 Search the scriptures**; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which **testify of me**.

### ... perhaps we see the hope for Nicodemus...

40 And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life.

**41** I receive not honour from men.

### 42 But I know you, that ye have not the love of God in you.

**43** I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

**44** How can ye believe, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that cometh from God only?

**45** Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is one that accuseth you, even Moses, in whom ye trust.

46 For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me; for he wrote of me.

47 But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?

<u>Confidence</u> – <u>NT:3954</u>  $\pi\alpha\rho\rho\eta\sigma$ í $\alpha$  **parrhesia** (par-rhay-see'-ah); from <u>NT:3956</u> and a derivative of <u>NT:4483</u>; all out-spokenness, i.e. frankness, bluntness, publicity; by implication, assurance:

 $\pmb{KJV}$  - bold (X -ly, -ness, -ness of speech), confidence,  $^{X}$  freely,  $^{X}$  openly,  $^{X}$  plainly (-ness).

<u>Ashamed</u> – <u>NT:153</u>αἰσχύνομαι **aischunomai** (ahee-skhoo'-nom-ahee); from **aischos** (disfigurement, i.e. disgrace); to feel shame (for oneself): **KJV** - be ashamed.

#### **Do Righteousness**

### 1 John 2

**29** If ye **know that he is righteous**, ye know that every one that **doeth <u>righteousness</u>** is **born of him**.

<u>Righteousness</u> – <u>NT:1343</u> δικαιοσύνη **dikaiosune** (dik-ah-yos-oo'-nay); from <u>NT:1342</u>; equity (of character or act); specially (Christian) justification: *KJV* - righteousness.

### **Manifests Christ**

#### 1 John 3

**8** He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might **destroy the works of the devil**.

### **Sinless in Christ**

#### 1 John 3

**9** Whosoever is **born of God doth not commit sin**; for his seed remaineth in him: and **he cannot sin**, because he is **born of God**.

### The Wicked can't touch this

#### 1 John 5

18 We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.

#### Do not out of character

#### 1 John 3

**10** In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever **doeth not** <u>righteousness</u> is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother. <u>Righteousness</u> – <u>NT:1343</u>δικαιοσύνη **dikaiosune** (dik-ah-yos-oo'-nay); from <u>NT:1342</u>; equity (of character or act); specially (Christian) justification: *KJV* - righteousness.

### Love one another

#### 1 John 4

**7** Beloved, let us **love one another**: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is **born** of God, and **knoweth God**.

### Believe that Jesus is not just a Prophet

#### 1 John 5

1 Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.

### Love the Son and Love the Father

### 1 John 5

**2** By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

**3** For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

### **Overcome the world**

#### 1 John 5

4 For whatsoever is born of God <u>overcometh</u> the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

<u>Overcometh</u> – <u>NT:3528</u> νικάω **nikao** (nik-ah'-o); from <u>NT:3529</u>; to subdue (literally or figuratively): *KJV* - conquer, overcome, prevail, get the victory.

### Follow after the example of Christ Jesus

### 1 Corinthians 15

**48** As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly.

### A Glorified body

### 1 Corinthians 15

**49** And as we have **borne the image of the earthy**, we shall also **bear the image of the heavenly**.

### **Colossians 1**

14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:15 Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:

### Inheritance

### 1 Corinthians 15

**50** Now this I say, brethren, that **flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God**; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

### John 7

43 So there was a division among the people because of him.

44 And some of them would have taken him; but no man laid hands on him.

**45** Then came the **officers to the chief priests and Pharisees**; and they said unto them, Why have ye not brought him?

**46** The officers answered, Never man spake like this man.

47 Then answered them the Pharisees, Are ye also deceived?

### 48 Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees believed on him?

49 But this people who knoweth not the law are cursed.

### John 7

50 Nicodemus saith unto them, (he that came to Jesus by night, being one of them,)

### 51 Doth our law judge any man, before it hear him, and know what he doeth?

**52** They answered and said unto him, Art thou also of Galilee? Search, and look: for out of Galilee ariseth no prophet.

53 And every man went unto his own house.

### Evidence of an innocent man...

#### John 19

**38** And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave him leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

**39** And there came also Nicodemus, which at the first came to Jesus by night, and brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about an hundred pound weight.

**40** Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury.

#### 1 Peter 1

**22** Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

**23 Being born again**, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

**24** For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:

**25** But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.
