Shadows of Light

Hebrews 10

¹ For the law having a **shadow of good things to come**, and **not the very image of the things, can never** with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually **make the comers thereunto perfect**.

Hebrews 1

³ Who being the brightness of His glory, and the **express image of His person**, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high:

...Cannot make us perfect

Psalm 19

⁷ **The law of the LORD is perfect**, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.

...Cannot purge our conscience

Hebrews 10

² For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the **worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins**.

...Cannot take away the memory

Hebrews 10

³ **But** in those sacrifices **there is a remembrance again** made of sins **every year**.

...Cannot take away sins

Hebrews 10

⁴ For it is **not possible** that the **blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins [EVER!]**.

Hebrews 10

¹¹ And **every priest** standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which **can never take away sins**:

Romans 11

²⁶ And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall **turn away ungodliness** from Jacob:

²⁷ For **this is my covenant** unto them, when **I shall take away their sins**.

²⁸ As concerning the gospel, they are **enemies for your sakes**: but as touching the election, they are **beloved for the father's sakes**.

1 John 3

⁵ And ye know that **He was manifested to take away our sins**; and **in Him is no sin**.

Shadows of Light (*cont*)

...Cannot please God

Hebrews 10

⁵ Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, **Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not**, but **a body hast thou prepared me**:

Hebrews 10

⁶ In **burnt offerings and sacrifices** for sin thou hast had **no pleasure**.

Romans 8

⁷ Because the **carnal mind is enmity against God**: for it is **not subject to the law of God**, neither indeed can be.

⁸ So then **they that are in the flesh cannot please God**.

⁹ But **ye are not in the flesh**, but **in the Spirit**, **if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you**. Now if any man **have not the Spirit of Christ**, he is none of His.

Hebrews 10

⁷ Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book **it is written of me**,) to **do thy will, O God**.

Hebrews 10

⁸ Above when he said, **Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin** thou wouldest **not, neither hadst pleasure** therein; which are **offered by the law**;

Psalms 40

⁶ **Sacrifice and offering** thou **didst not desire**; mine ears hast thou opened: **burnt offering and sin offering** hast thou not required.

⁷ Then said I, Lo, I come: **in the volume of the book it is written of me**,

⁸ **I delight to do thy will**, O my God: yea, **thy law is within my heart**.

Psalms 143

¹⁰ **Teach me to do thy will**; for thou art my God: thy spirit is good; lead me into the land of uprightness.

Sun of Light

Hebrews 10 ...Jesus needeth NOT to be taught!

⁹ Then said He, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. **He** taketh away the first, that **He** may establish the second.

...Could do His will

...Could sanctify for all time, for ever

Hebrews 10

¹⁰ By the which will **we are sanctified** through the offering of the **body of Jesus Christ once for all [time, “for ever”]**.

Sanctified – [NT:37](#) ἁγιάζω **hagiazō** (hag-ee-ad'-zo); from [NT:40](#); to make holy, i.e. (ceremonially) purify or consecrate; (mentally) to venerate:

KJV - hallow, be holy, sanctify.

Exodus 29

⁴⁴ And I will sanctify the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar: I will sanctify also both Aaron and his sons, to minister to me in the priest's office.

Exodus 31

¹³ Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that I am the LORD that doth sanctify you.

Colossians 2

¹⁶ Let no man therefore judge you in **meat**, or in **drink**, or in respect of an **holyday**, or of the **new moon**, or of the **sabbath days**:

¹⁷ Which are a **shadow of things to come**; but the **body is of Christ**.

¹⁸ Let no man beguile you of your reward in a **voluntary humility** and worshipping of angels, **intruding** into those **things which he hath not seen**, vainly **puffed up by his fleshly mind**,

¹⁹ And not **holding the Head**, from which all the body by joints and bands having **nourishment ministered**, and **knit together**, **increaseth with the increase of God**.

...Could accomplish with one offering

Hebrews 10

¹² But this man [Jesus of Nazareth, the Christ], after He had **offered one sacrifice for sins for ever [for all time]**, sat down on the right hand of God;

Sun of Light (*cont*)

Hebrews 10 ...because remission was already accomplished

¹⁸ Now where **remission** of these is, there is **no more offering for sin**.

Matthew 26

²⁸ For this is my blood of the new testament, which is **shed for many for the remission of sins**.

Hebrews 9

²² And **almost all things** are by the law purged with blood; and **without shedding of blood is no remission**.

Romans 3

²⁵ Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

...Could expect enemies under foot

Hebrews 10

¹³ From **henceforth expecting** till **His enemies be made His footstool**.

Psalms 110

¹ The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy **footstool**.

Ephesians 1

²⁰ Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,

²¹ Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

²² And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church,

²³ Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

...Could offer Himself a perfect offering

Hebrews 10

¹⁴ For **by one offering** He hath **perfected** for ever **them that are sanctified** [us, the saints].

...Could sanctify us

God Has Sanctified!

Sun of Light (*cont*)

...Could provide two or three witnesses of Himself

Hebrews 10

¹⁵ Whereof the **Holy Ghost also is a witness** to us: for after that **He [the Holy Ghost] had said before,**

Hebrews 10

²⁸ **He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:**

Hebrews 10

¹⁶ **This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;**

...Could take away memory of sin

Hebrews 10

¹⁷ **And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.**

Jeremiah 31

³³ **But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.**

³⁴ **And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.**

...Could enter holy of holies

Hebrews 10

¹⁹ **Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,**

Sun of Light (*cont*)

...Could show Himself a man consecrated from the beginning

Hebrews 10

²⁰By a **new and living way**, which **He hath consecrated** for us, **through the veil**, that is to say, **His flesh**;

Hebrews 8

⁴For if he were on earth, he should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law:

⁵Who serve unto **the example and shadow of heavenly things**, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, that thou make all things **according to the pattern** shewed to thee in the mount.

⁶But now hath he **obtained a more excellent ministry**, by how much also he is the **mediator of a better covenant**, which was **established upon better promises**.

...Could show Himself greater than the House he builded

Hebrews 10

²¹And having an **high priest** over the **House of God**;

...Could bring full assurance of pureness

Hebrews 10

²²Let us **draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith**, having our hearts **sprinkled from an evil conscience**, and our **bodies washed with pure water**.

...Could fulfil His promises

Saints in Light

...Profession of Faith

Hebrews 10 ...without wavering

²³ Let us **hold fast** the profession of our faith without wavering; (for He is faithful that promised;)

Hebrews 10 ...in love and good works

²⁴ And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

Hebrews 10 ...worshipping together with saints

²⁵ Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, **as ye see the day approaching.**

God Has Sanctified!

Sinners under Light

...Subject to sin

Hebrews 10

²⁶ For **if we sin wilfully** after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,

...Subject to judgment

Hebrews 10

²⁷ But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.

...Subject to punishment

Hebrews 10

²⁹ Of how much **sorer punishment**, suppose ye, shall he be thought **worthy**, who hath **trodden under foot the Son of God**, and hath **counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith He was sanctified**, an **unholy thing**, and **hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?**

Psalm 149

⁶ Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand;

⁷ To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and **punishments upon the people;**

⁸ To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron;

...Subject to vengeance

Hebrews 10

³⁰ For **we know Him** that hath said, **Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense**, saith the Lord. And again, **The Lord shall judge His people.**

Deuteronomy 32

³⁵ **To me belongeth vengeance and recompence;** their foot shall slide in due time: for the day of their calamity is at hand, and the things that shall come upon them make haste.

Deuteronomy 32

⁴¹ If I whet my glittering sword, and mine hand take hold on judgment; I will render **vengeance** to mine enemies, and will reward them that hate me.

Jeremiah 20

¹² But, O LORD of hosts, that triest the righteous, and seest the reins and the heart, let me see thy **vengeance** on them: for unto thee have I opened my cause.

Sinners under Light (*cont*)

...Subject to vengeance (*cont*)

Ezekiel 25

¹⁴ And I will lay my **vengeance** upon Edom by the hand of my people Israel: and they shall do in Edom according to mine anger and according to my fury; and they shall know my **vengeance**, saith the Lord GOD.

Micah 5

¹⁵ And I will execute **vengeance** in anger and fury upon the heathen, such as they have not heard.

Nahum 1

² God is jealous, and the LORD revengeth; the LORD revengeth, and is furious; the LORD will take **vengeance** on his adversaries, and he reserveth wrath for his enemies.

Romans 12

¹⁹ Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, **Vengeance** is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

...Subject to heavy hand of the living God

Hebrews 10

³¹ It is a fearful thing to **fall into the hands of the living God.**

Isaiah 35

⁴ Say to them that are of a **fearful heart, Be strong, fear not:** behold, your **God will come with vengeance**, even **God with a recompence; he will come and save you.**

2 Thessalonians 1

⁷ And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels,

⁸ In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:

⁹ Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;

Moon Light

...illuminated

Hebrews 10

³² But call to remembrance the former days, in which, after ye were **illuminated**, ye endured a great fight of afflictions;

...shown to all the world

Hebrews 10

³³ Partly, whilst ye were **made a gazingstock** both by **reproaches and afflictions**; and partly, whilst ye **became companions** of them that were so used.

...enduring

Hebrews 10

³⁴ For ye had **compassion** of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that **ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance**.

...unwavering

Hebrews 10

³⁵ **Cast not away therefore your confidence**, which hath **great recompence of reward**.

...responsive

Hebrews 10

³⁶ For ye have need of **patience**, that, after ye have **done the will of God**, ye might **receive the promise**.

Patience – [NT:5281](#) ὑπομονή **hupomone** (hoop-om-on-ay'); from [NT:5278](#); cheerful (or hopeful) endurance, constancy:

KJV - enduring, patience, patient continuance (waiting).

Hebrews 10

³⁷ For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry.

Summary – Sanctified by the Light

Leviticus 20

⁷ Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy: for I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 21

⁸ Thou shalt sanctify him therefore; for he offereth the bread of thy God: he shall be holy unto thee: **for I the LORD, which sanctify you, am holy.**

Romans 15

¹⁶ That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being **sanctified by the Holy Ghost.**

1 Thessalonians 4

³ For this is the **will of God**, even your sanctification, that ye should **abstain from fornication**:

Sanctification – [NT:38](#) ἁγιασμός **hagiasmos** (hag-ee-as-mos'); from [NT:37](#); properly, purification, i.e. (the state) purity; concretely (by Hebraism) a purifier:
KJV - holiness, sanctification.

Innocent...

Hebrews 10

³⁸ Now **the just shall live by faith**: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

...for Life

...to please God

Guilty...

Hebrews 10

³⁹ But **we are not of them who draw back** unto perdition; but **of them that believe** to the saving of the soul.

...unto Death

...no pleasing God

James 1

²³ For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:

²⁴ For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.

²⁵ But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be **blessed in his deed.**

²⁶ If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.

God Has Sanctified!

Summary – Sanctified by the Light (*cont*)

Philippians 3

⁹ And be found in him, **not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law**, but that which is **through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:**

¹⁰ That I may **know him**, and the **power of his resurrection**, and the **fellowship of his sufferings**, being made **conformable unto his death;**

¹¹ If by any means I might **attain unto the resurrection** of the dead.

¹² **Not as though I had already attained**, either were **already perfect**: but I **follow after**, if **that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.**

¹³ Brethren, I **count not myself to have apprehended**: but this **one thing I do**, forgetting those things which are behind, and **reaching forth unto those things which are before,**

¹⁴ I **press toward the mark** for the **prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.**

Why?! ...because God has sanctified!
