Church on the Rock Assembly is a vast a vibrant LORD's ministry which is focused upon the Work of God especially in India and, also, countries throughout Africa. Our mission is to preach the Gospel, disciple the saints, edify the church in love.

Several years ago I prayed the LORD open up Africa for us and I spoke to our first pastor, Pastor Byichaza, who lived in DR Congo and who had been following our teaching. I began to open the Word more perfectly and teaching him in December 2014. I simply shared our Doctrinal Statement. He heard the TRUTH and a great blessing ensued for him, for me, and so many pastors and so many congregants as ministry began to bloom. Then, the LORD began to add pastors in different countries across Africa.

What was different in the ministry in Africa is that I spoke with or, most often, could only text with each lead pastor with the stipulation in Africa that only those whom the LORD gave Revelation to receive our Doctrinal Statement and only those who agreed and desired to join with us would be members of the Church on the Rock Assembly. Only these could be members. Of course, we would never prevent the Doctrinal Statement from being adopted by anyone whom the LORD revealed it's TRUTH; in fact, we encouraged it. However, much to my amazement, all those who have happily received the Doctrinal Statement have, with joy, actually insisted that they are CHURCH ON THE ROCK ASSEMBLY. Now, as I consider our first occasion, in 2002, to call ourselves by that name, it was the LORD's endowment upon His church which we also, and in like manner, insisted that we had seen the Revelation of Christ our King and that we are CHURCH ON THE ROCK ASSEMBLY.

In just a couple of years now, we have seen the LORD draw many pastors and pastors of pastors and so many congregants unto the LORD's ministry. Among all the members of CHURCH ON THE ROCK ASSEMBLY we have the MIND OF CHRIST and are devoted to being LIKEMINDED and edifying the church in the LOVE OF GOD. What had been camouflaged by the traditions of men was suddenly and miraculously clear and made apparent through the simplicity of the GOSPEL we teach through the use of our Doctrinal Statement. Suddenly, for so very many, the clear TRUTH of God was absolutely apparent. The LORD motivated me to better define our complex doctrinal statement in a Bible study in 2008. In 6 months, what evolved during

our Bible study was a Doctrinal Statement that brought clarification and simplification of the Gospel message, as it is intended to be presented, while showing the fundamental foundations of our faith in an outline that was filled with the Scriptures to legitimize the document that has now inspired many by the grace of God. Through our obedience to prepare our Doctrinal Statement, the LORD has now used it to touch the hearts and save the souls of thousands who now know and share the absolute TRUTH of God.

Our pastors are faithful followers of the ONLY ONE LORD JEHOVAH and our congregations are growing daily in the love of God who indwells them perpetually, and sustains them in the knowledge of God, and the understanding of God, to act with the wisdom of God. Even now, I am insistent that we teach and preach, but as much as I want to supply them food for their physical needs, I also want to supply them Bibles to know they can continue to be nourished by the fodder of God's WORD.

Many thanks to you all who continue to pray and to give faithfully to this true LORD's ministry.
