PRAISE

Psalm 33

Praise the LORD

1 Rejoice in the LORD, O ye <u>righteous</u>: for praise is <u>comely</u> for the <u>upright</u>.

Righteous – OT:6662 >qyD!x^ > tsaddiyg (tsad-deek'); from OT:6663; just:

KJV - just, lawful, righteous (man).

...from – OT:6663 < > tsadaq (tsaw-dak'); a primitive root; to be (causatively, make) right (in a moral or forensic sense):

KJV - cleanse, clearself, (be, do) just (-ice, -ify, -ifyself), (be turn to) righteous (-ness).

<u>Comely</u> – OT:5000 >hw#an* > na'veh (naw-veh'); from OT:4998 or OT:5116; suitable, or beautiful: KJV - becometh, comely, seemly.

<u>Upright</u> – OT:3477 >rv*y* > yashar (yaw-shawr'); from OT:3474; straight (literally or figuratively): -convenient, equity, Jasher, <u>just</u>, meet (-est), <u>pleased well right</u> (-eous), <u>straight</u>, (most) upright (-ly, -ness).

Proverbs 28

4 They that forsake the law **praise the wicked**: but such as keep the law <u>contend</u> with them.

<u>Contend</u> – OT:1624 >hr*G* > garah (gaw-raw'); a primitive root; properly, to grate, i.e. (figuratively) to anger: KJV - contend, meddle, stir up, strive.

Hope in adversity

Jeremiah 17:17

Be not a terror unto me: thou art my hope in the day of evil.

Hope is worshipful, healthful, and pleasing

Psalm 43

5 Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? **hope in God:** for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God.

Psalm 33

How we Praise the LORD

2 Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery and an instrument of ten strings.

Hope yields gladness with great expectation

Proverbs 10

28 The **hope of the righteous shall be gladness**: but the expectation of the wicked shall perish.

Psalm 16

9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall **rest in hope**.

Psalm 22

9 But thou art he that took me out of the womb: **thou didst make me hope** when I was upon my mother's breasts.

Psalm 71

14 But I will hope continually, and will yet praise thee more and more.

Psalm 33 - Cherish your hopes

Psalm 33 ... The Context of our Praise to the LORD

3 Sing unto him a **new song**; play skilfully with a loud noise.

Psalm 40 ... God's Song sung by those who fear God and Trust Him

3 And he hath put a **new song** in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall **trust in the LORD**.

Psalm 98 ...why we sing praise

1 O sing unto the LORD a **new song**; for [because] he hath done **marvellous things**: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory.

Psalm 144

9 I will sing a **new song** unto thee, O God: upon a psaltery and an instrument of ten strings will I sing praises unto thee.

Psalm 96:1...all shall sing in the day we shall reign

O sing unto the LORD a **new song**: sing unto the LORD, **all the earth.**

Isaiah 42

10 Sing unto the LORD a **new song**, and his praise from the end of the earth, ye that go down to the sea, and all that is therein; the isles, and the inhabitants thereof.

Psalm 149 ...the congregation shall sing

1 Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a **new song**, and his praise in the congregation of saints.

Revelation 5 ... sung to the LORD who is worthy to open...

9 And they sung a **new song**, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

Revelation 14

3 And they sung as it were a **new song** before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that **song** but the **hundred and forty and four thousand [144,000]**, which were redeemed from the earth.

Psalm 33 - Cherish your hopes The Word of the LORD

Psalm 33

4 For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth.

<u>Right</u> – <u>Upright</u> [verse 33:1] – OT:3477 >rv*y* > yashar (yaw-shawr'); from OT:3474; straight (literally or figuratively): -convenient, equity, Jasher, <u>just</u>, meet (-est), <u>pleased well right</u> (-eous), <u>straight</u>, (most) upright (-ly, -ness).

<u>Works</u> – OT:4639 >hc#u&m^ > ma`aseh (mah-as-eh'); from OT:6213; an action (good or bad); generally, a transaction; abstractly, activity; by implication, a product (specifically, a poem) or (generally) property:

KJV - act, art, bakemeat, business, deed, do (-ing), labor, thing made, ware of making, occupation, thing offered, operation, possession, well, ([handy-, needle-, net-]) work (ing, - manship), wrought.

<u>Truth</u> – OT:530 >hn*Wma\$ > 'emuwnah (em-oo-naw'); or (shortened) 'emunah (em-oo-naw'); feminine of OT:529; literally firmness; figuratively security; morally fidelity:

KJV - faith (-ful, -ly, -ness, [man]), set office, stability, steady, truly, truth, verily.

Ephesians 1

13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

...as only our LORD GOD could promise

James 1:18

Of his own will **begat he us with the word of truth**, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

Hope in a promise of God

Acts 26

6 And now I stand and am judged for the **hope of the promise** made of God, unto our fathers:

Hope is Enduring

1 Thessalonians 1:3

Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of **hope in** our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father;

Hope is our Refuge

Psalm 119

114 Thou art my hiding place and my shield: I hope in thy word.

Psalm 119

81 My soul fainteth for thy salvation: but I hope in thy word.

Psalm 119

49 Remember the word unto thy servant, upon which thou hast caused me to hope.

Psalm 130

5 I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.

Psalm 33 - Cherish your hopes The Love of the Lord

Psalm 33

5 He <u>loveth</u> righteousness [tsadeq] and <u>judgment</u>: the earth is <u>full</u> of the <u>goodness</u> of the LORD. <u>Loveth</u> – OT:157 >bh^a^ > 'ahab (ah'-hab); from OT:157; <u>affection</u> (in a good or a bad sense): KJV - love (-r).

...from - OT:159 < >bh^a) > 'ohab (o'-hab); from OT:156; meaning the same as OT:158: KJV - love.

...from – OT:160 < >hb*h&a^ > 'ahabah (a-hab-aw); feminine of OT:158 and meaning the same: KJV - love.

<u>Judgment</u> – OT:4941 >fP*v=m! > mishpat (mish-pawt'); from OT:8199; properly, a verdict (favorable or unfavorable) pronounced judicially, especially a sentence or formal decree (human or [participant's] divine law, individual or collective), including the act, the place, the suit, the crime, and the penalty; abstractly, justice, including a participant's right or privilege (statutory or customary), or even a style:

KJV - adversary, ceremony, charge, crime, custom, desert, determination, discretion, disposing, due, fashion, form, to be judged, judgment, just (-ice, -ly), (manner of) law (-ful), manner, measure, (due) order, ordinance, right, sentence, usest, worthy, wrong.

<u>Full</u> – OT:4390 >al@m* > male' (maw-lay'); or mala' (Est 7:5) (maw-law'); a primitive root, to fill or (intransitively) be full of, in a wide application (literally and figuratively):

KJV - <u>accomplish</u>, confirm, consecrate, be at an end, be expired, be fenced, fill, fulfil, (be, become, draw, give in, go) full (-ly, -ly set, tale), [over-] flow, fulness, furnish, gather (selves, together), presume, replenish, <u>satisfy</u>, set, space, take a [hand-] full, <u>have wholly</u>.

Goodness – OT:2617 >ds#j# > checed (kheh'-sed); from OT:2616; kindness; by implication

Goodness – O1:2617 >ds#j# > checed (kheh'-sed); from O1:2616; kindness; by implication (towards God) piety: rarely (by opposition) reproof, or (subject.) beauty:

KJV - favour, good deed (-liness, -ness), kindly, (loving-) kindness, merciful (kindness), mercy, pity, reproach, wicked thing.

Psalm 37

28 For **the LORD loveth judgment**, and forsaketh not his saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.

Hope for Mercy and redemption

Psalm 130

7 Let Israel **hope in the LORD**: for with the LORD **there is mercy**, and with him is plenteous **redemption**.

Deuteronomy 7

8 But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

Isaiah 63 ... Caring for His beloved

9 In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence saved them: in his love and in his pity he redeemed them; and he bare them, and carried them all the days of old

Psalm 147

11 The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy.

Psalm 33 - Cherish your hopes Creation

Psalm 33

6 By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.

7 He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap: he layeth up the depth in storehouses.

Psalm 33 ...all shall revere Him upon the earth in that day

8 Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.

9 For he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.

Isaiah 44

24 Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I am the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens **alone**; that spreadeth abroad the earth **by myself**;

10 The LORD bringeth the counsel of the heathen to nought: he maketh the devices of the people of none effect.

Ecclesiastes 1 ... as determined

9 The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is **no new thing under the sun**.

Psalm 33 ...contrast God's counsel

11 The counsel of the LORD standeth for ever, the thoughts of his heart to all generations.

Psalm 33 ...the whole nation of God

12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD; and the people whom he hath **chosen** for his own inheritance.

Hope in an Inheritance

Lamentations 3

24 The LORD is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him.

<u>Portion</u> – OT:2506 >ql#j@ > cheleq (khay'lek); from OT:2505; properly, smoothness (of the tongue); also an allotment: KJV - flattery, inheritance, part, partake, portion.

Psalm 33 ...

13 The LORD looketh from heaven; he beholdeth all the sons of men.

Hebrews 10

31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

14 From the place of his habitation he looketh upon all the inhabitants of the earth.

Isaiah 45

18 For thus saith the LORD that **created the heavens**; **God himself** that formed the earth and made it; **he hath established it**, he **created it not in vain**, he **formed it to be inhabited**: I am the LORD; and **there is none else**.

Psalm 33 - Cherish your hopes Creator

Psalm 33

15 He fashioneth [determined and moulded] their hearts alike; he considereth all their works.

Job 31:15

Did not he that made me in the womb make him? and did not one **fashion** us in the womb?

Isaiah 45

- 7 I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things.
- **8** Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness: let the earth open, and let them bring forth salvation, and let righteousness spring up together; I the LORD have created it.
- **9** Woe unto him that striveth with his Maker! Let the potsherd strive with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay say to him that fashioneth it, What makest thou? or thy work, He hath no hands?

Hope in this life and for life

Psalm 131:3

Let Israel hope in the LORD from henceforth and for ever.

Proverbs 14:32 ...until death

The wicked is driven away in his wickedness: but the righteous **hath hope in his death.**

Job 27:8 ...not so for the wicked

For what is the **hope of the** hypocrite, though he hath gained, when God taketh away his soul?

Hope in the hereafter

1 Corinthians 15

19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.

Jeremiah 31

17 And **there is hope in thine end**, saith the LORD, that thy children shall come again to their own border.

Hope is the anchor

Hebrews 6

19 Which **hope we have as an anchor of the soul**, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

Hope is steadfast

Colossians 1

23 If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be **not moved away** from the **hope of the gospel [good message]**, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;

Hope draws us unto God

Hebrews 7

19 For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope did; by the which we draw nigh unto God.

By faith we Hope

Hebrews 11

1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Psalm 33 - Cherish your hopes Deliverer

Psalm 33

16 There is **no king saved by the multitude of an host**: a mighty man is not delivered by much strength.

Hope makes us to be courageous and strong

Psalm 31

24 Be of good courage, and he shall **strengthen your heart**, all ye that **hope in** the LORD.

- 17 An horse is a vain thing for safety: neither shall he deliver any by his great strength.
- **18** Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy;
- **19** To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine.
- **20** Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield.
- **21** For **our heart** [which he hath fashioned] shall rejoice in him, because we have trusted in his **holy name**.

Ezekiel 11

19 And I will give them **one heart**, and I will put a **new spirit** within you; and I will **take the stony heart** out of their flesh, and will give them an **heart of flesh**:

Ezekiel 18

31 Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a **new heart** and a **new spirit**: for why will ye die, O house of Israel?

Ezekiel 36

Psalm 33

22 Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we hope in thee.

According as – OT:834 >rv#a&> 'asher (ash-er'); a primitive relative pronoun (of every gender and number); who, which, what, that; also (as an adverb and a conjunction) when, where, how, because, in order that, etc.:

KJV - after, alike, as (soon as), because, every, for, forasmuch, from whence, how (-soever), if, (so) that ([thing] which, wherein), though, until, whatsoever, when, where (+-as, -in, -of, -on, -soever, -with), which, whilst, whither (-soever), who (-m, -soever, -se). As it is indeclinable, it is often accompanied by the personal pronoun expletively, used to show the connection.

Hebrews 8

10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

Hebrews 10

16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;

Hope is strengthened by every remembrance

Psalm 78

7 That they might **set their hope in God**, and not forget the works of God, but **keep his commandments**:

Hope is purifying

1 John 3

- **1** Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.
- **2** Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
- **3** And every man that hath this **hope in him purifieth himself**, even as he is pure.

Hope gives us access to the throne of God

Romans 5

2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Psalm 33 - Cherish your hopes Cherish your hopes (cont)

Psalm 118

23 This is the LORD's doing; it is marvellous in our eyes.

Ephesians 5

16 Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.

Redeeming – NT:1805 >e)cagora/zw > exagorazo (ex-ag-or-ad'-zo); from NT:1537 and NT:59; to buy up, i.e. ransom; figuratively, to rescue from loss (improve opportunity): KJV - redeem.

24 This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.

25 Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech thee, send now <u>prosperity</u>. <u>Prosperity</u> – OT:6744 >jl^x* > tsalach (tsaw-lakh'); or tsaleach (tsaw-lay'-akh); a primitive root; to push forward, in various senses (literal or figurative, transitive or intransitive): KJV - break out, come (mightily), go over, be good, be meet, be profitable, (cause to, effect, make to, send) prosper (-ity, -ous, -ously).

...from – OT:6744 jl^x= tselach (Aramaic) (tsel-akh'); corresponding to OT:6743; to advance (transitive or intransitive): KJV - promote, prosper.

We are creatures made new who must not forget...

...but rather Cherish the promises, steadfast in the message from our God who created all things, and created us to loves us to please Him nd love Him remembering all that he alone has written in our hearts and minds according only to the Word of the LORD who made us holy as he is holy (even as we shall ever be)

Approaching the throne in pureness

...and so we Cherish our hopes of always knowing the Goodness of the Father is ahead of us

1 Peter 3

14 But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled;

15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

16 Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ.
