

Blessed Creation – Day 3

We see the Creator and the Creation of God...

Dry Ground Appears

Genesis 1

9 And **God said**, Let the **waters under the heaven** be **gathered together** unto one place, and **let the dry land appear**: and it was so.

Gathered together – OT:6960 >קָוַה > qavah (kaw-vaw'); a primitive root; to bind together (perhaps by twisting), i.e. collect; (figuratively) to expect:
KJV - gather (together), look, patiently, tarry, wait (for, on, upon).

Seas Gathered Apart from the Dry Ground

10 And God called the **dry land Earth**; and the **gathering together of the waters** called he **Seas**: and **God saw that it was good**.

Dry land – OT:3004 >יַבְשָׁה > yabbashah (yab-baw-shaw'); from OT:3001; dry ground:
KJV - dry (ground, land).

...from – OT:3001 >שָׁבַח > yabesh (yaw-bashe'); a primitive root; to be ashamed, confused or disappointed; also (as failing) to dry up (as water) or wither (as herbage): -be ashamed, clean, be confounded, (make) dry (up), (do) shame (-fully), utterly, wither (away).

Earth – OT:776 >אֶרֶץ > 'erets (eh'-rets); from an unused root probably meaning to be firm; the earth (at large, or partitively a land):

KJV - common, country, earth, field, ground, land, natins, way, wilderness, world.

Seas – OT:3220 >יָם > yam (yawm); from an unused root meaning to roar; a sea (as breaking in noisy surf) or large body of water; specifically (with the article), the Mediterranean Sea; sometimes a large river, or an artificial basin; locally, the west, or (rarely) the south: KJV - sea (X -faring man, [-shore]), south, west (-ern, side, -ward).

The Lord God Commands Earth

11 And **God said**, **Let the earth bring forth grass**, the **herb yielding seed**, and the **fruit tree yielding fruit** after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and **it was so**.

Grass and Seed and Fruit come forth from the Earth

12 And the **earth brought forth grass**, and **herb yielding seed** after his kind, and the **tree yielding fruit**, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and God saw that **it was good**.

Good – OT:2896 >טוֹב > towb (tobe); from OT:2895; good (as an adjective) in the widest sense; used likewise as a noun, both in the masculine and the feminine, the singular and the plural (good, a good or good thing, a good man or woman; the good, goods or good things, good men or women), also as an adverb (well):

KJV - beautiful, best, better, bountiful, cheerful, at ease, fair (word), (be in) favour, fine, glad, good (deed, -lier, -lieth, -ly, -ness, -s), graciously, joyful, kindly, kindness, liketh (best), loving, merry, most, pleasant, pleaseth, pleasure, precious, prosperity, ready, sweet, wealth, welfare, (be) well ([-favoured]).

Close of a Good Day

13 And the evening and the morning were the third day.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

We see the Desire of God...

Desire to Publish His word

Deuteronomy 32

1 Give ear, O ye heavens, and I will speak [declare, rehearse, command]; and hear [what is told], O earth, the words of my mouth.

Speak – OT:1696 > דַּבַּר > dabar (daw-bar'); a primitive root; perhaps properly, to arrange; but used figuratively (of words), to speak; rarely (in a destructive sense) to subdue:
KJV - answer, appoint, bid, command, commune, declare, destroy, give, name, promise, pronounce, rehearse, say, speak, be spokesman, subdue, talk, teach, tell, think, use [entreaties], utter, well, work.

Words – OT:561 > אָמַר > 'emer (ay'-mer; from OT:559; something said:

KJV - answer, appointed unto him, saying, speech, word.

2 My **doctrine shall drop [drip] as the rain**, my **speech [commandment] shall distil as the dew**, as the **small rain upon the tender herb**, and as the **showers upon the grass**:

Doctrine – OT:3948 > לָקַח > leqach (leh'-kakh); from OT:3947; properly, something received, i.e. (mentally) instruction (whether on the part of the teacher or hearer); also (in an active and sinister sense) inveiglement:

KJV - doctrine, learning, fair speech.

...from – Hbr – to take...

Distil – OT:5140 > נָזַל > nazal (naw-zal'); a primitive root; to drip, or shed by trickling:

KJV - distil, drop, flood, (cause to) flow (-ing), gush out, melt, pour (down), running water, stream.

Tender herb – OT:1877 > דֶּשֶׁה > deshe' (deh'-sheh); from OT:1876; a sprout; by analogy, grass:

KJV - (tender) grass, green, (tender) herb.

3 Because I will **publish the name of the LORD**: ascribe ye greatness unto our God.

Exodus 33

19 And he said, **I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee**; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.

Exodus 34

5 And the **LORD descended in the cloud**, and stood with him there, and **proclaimed the name of the LORD**.

Desire to Spring forth Knowledge

2 Samuel 23

3 The God of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spake to me, He that ruleth over men must be just, ruling in the fear of God.

4 And he shall be as the light of the morning, when the sun riseth, even a morning without clouds; as the tender **grass springing out of the earth by clear shining after rain**.

5 Although my house be not so with God; yet he hath made with me an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things, and sure: for this is all my salvation, and all my desire, although he make it not to grow.

Isaiah 11 ...seeds are planted in the earth by the Lord God!

9 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: **for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea**.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire to Bless those that Spring forth

Psalm 65

9 Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it: thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, which is full of water: thou preparest them corn, when thou hast so provided for it.

10 Thou **waterest the ridges** thereof abundantly: thou **settlest the furrows** thereof: thou makest it soft with showers: thou **blessest the springing thereof**.

11 Thou crownest the year with thy goodness; and thy paths drop fatness.

12 They drop upon the pastures of the wilderness: and the little hills rejoice on every side.

13 The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for joy, they also sing.

Desire to Feed Man and Cattle

Psalm 104

13 He watereth the hills from his chambers: the earth is satisfied with the fruit of thy works.

14 He causeth the **grass to grow for the cattle**, and **herb for the service of man**: that he may bring forth **food out of the earth**;

15 And wine that maketh glad the heart of man, and oil to make his face to shine, and bread which strengtheneth man's heart.

Deuteronomy 11

15 And **I will send grass in thy fields for thy cattle, that thou mayest eat and be full**.

Daniel 4 ...of Nebuchadnezzar

14 He cried aloud, and said thus, Hew down the tree, and cut off his branches, shake off his leaves, and scatter his fruit: let the beasts get away from under it, and the fowls from his branches:

15 Nevertheless leave the stump of his roots in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the **tender grass** of the field; and let it be **wet with the dew of heaven**, and let his **portion be with the beasts in the grass of the earth**:

16 Let his heart be **changed from man's**, and let a beast's heart be given unto him; and let **seven times** pass over him.

Desire to Show it was Purposeful

Isaiah 55 ...it was done with purpose...

9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

10 **For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:**

11 **So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.**

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire to Show He is Sufficiency

John 6

49 Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead.

John 6

58 This is that **bread which came down from heaven**: not as your fathers did eat **manna**, and are dead: he that **eateth of this bread** shall live for ever.

Psalm 78

24 And had **rained down manna** upon them to eat, and had given them of the **corn of heaven**.

Numbers 11

9 And when the dew fell upon the camp in the night, the **manna** fell upon it.

John 6

33 For the **bread of God** is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.

34 Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread.

35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: **he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.**

John 4

14 But whosoever **drinketh of the water that I shall give** him shall **never thirst**; but the **water** that I shall give him shall be in him a **well of water springing up into everlasting life**.

**Note: They ate yet they thirsted...else they drank yet they hungered...
...because of unbelief**

Matthew 4

4 But he answered and said, It is written, **Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.**

Luke 4

4 And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, **That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.**

John 7

37 In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, **If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.**

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire to Offer Comfort

Matthew 14

18 He said, Bring them hither to me.

19 And he **commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass**, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake, and gave the loaves to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

20 And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full.

Mark 6

38 He saith unto them, How many loaves have ye? go and see. And when they knew, they say, Five, and two fishes.

39 And he commanded them to **make all sit down by companies upon the green grass**.

Green ...from – NT:5514 > הַיָּוֹנֵץ > Chloe (khlo'-ay); feminine of apparently a primary word; "green"; Chloe, a Christian female: KJV - Chloe.

Grass – NT:5528 > הַחֹרְתוֹס > chortos (khor'-tos); apparently a primary word; a "court" or "garden", i.e. (by implication, of pasture) herbage or vegetation: KJV - blade, grass, hay.

40 And they sat down in ranks, by hundreds, and by fifties.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire to show His Sovereignty

Matthew 8 ...of our Lord God they said...

27 But the men marvelled, saying, What manner of **man** is this, that even the winds and the **sea** obey him! [**...His creation will follow his every commandment!**]

Isaiah 37

26 Hast thou not heard long ago, **how I have done it**; and of ancient times, **that I have formed it?** now have **I brought it to pass**, that thou shouldst be to lay waste defenced cities into ruinous heaps.

27 Therefore their inhabitants were of **small power**, they were **dismayed** and **confounded**: **they were as the grass of the field**, and **as the green herb**, as the **grass on the housetops**, and as corn blasted before it be grown up.

28 But **I know thy abode**, and thy **going out**, and thy **coming in**, and thy **rage against me**.

Psalm 129 ..over the wicked

1 Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth, may Israel now say:

2 Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth: yet they have not prevailed against me.

3 The plowers plowed upon my back: they made long their furrows.

4 The LORD is righteous: he hath cut asunder the cords of the wicked.

5 Let them all be confounded and turned back that hate Zion.

6 **Let them be as the grass upon the housetops**, which withereth afore it groweth up:

7 Wherewith the **mower filleth not his hand**; **nor he that bindeth sheaves his bosom**.

8 Neither do they which go by say, The blessing of the LORD be upon you: we bless you in the name of the LORD. [upon them is no blessing or name of the Lord]

1 Corinthians 3 ...over the righteous

7 So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but **God that giveth the increase**.

8 Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour.

9 For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.

Building – NT:3619 >οἰκοδομή > oikodome (oy-kod-om-ay'); feminine (abstract) of a compound of NT:3624 and the base of NT:1430; architecture, i.e. (concretely) a structure; figuratively, **confirmation**: KJV - building, edify (-ication, -ing).

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire to Limit the History of life on Earth

Psalm 103

14 For he knoweth our frame; he remembereth that we are dust.

15 As for man, his **days are as grass**: as a flower of the field, so he flourisheth.

16 For the **wind passeth over it**, and **it is gone**; and the place thereof shall know it no more.

Genesis 6 ...in the day of Noah

3 And the LORD said, **My spirit shall not always strive with man**, for that he also is flesh: **yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years [120 years]**.

Zechariah 1

12 Then the angel of the LORD answered and said, O LORD of hosts, **how long wilt thou not have mercy on Jerusalem** and on the cities of Judah, against which thou hast had indignation these **threescore and ten years**?

Psalm 90

10 **The days of our years are threescore years and ten [70 years]**; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away.

Proverbs 27

24 **For riches are not for ever**: and doth the crown endure to every generation?

25 The hay appeareth, and the tender grass **sheweth itself**, and **herbs of the mountains are gathered**.

Tender grass – OT:1877 >שֶׁבֶט > deshe' (deh'-sheh); from OT:1876; a sprout; by analogy, grass: KJV - (tender) grass, green, (tender) herb.

26 The **lambs are for thy clothing**, and the **goats are the price of the field**.

Desire to Show Himself in the History of Man

Isaiah 40

5 And the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.

6 The voice said, Cry. And he said, What shall I cry? **All flesh is grass, and all the goodness thereof is as the flower of the field**:

7 The **grass withereth**, the **flower fadeth**: because the spirit of the LORD bloweth upon it: **surely the people is grass**.

8 The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: **but the word of our God shall stand for ever**.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire to Show Himself to His tender children

Isaiah 44

3 For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring:

4 And they shall **spring up as among the grass**, as willows by the water courses.

5 One shall say, I am the LORD's; and another shall call himself by the name of Jacob; and another shall subscribe with his hand unto the LORD, and surname himself by the name of Israel.

Psalm 72

1 Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son.

2 He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment.

3 The **mountains shall bring peace to the people**, and the little hills, by righteousness.

4 He **shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy**, and shall break in pieces the oppressor.

5 **They shall fear thee as long as the sun and moon endure**, throughout all generations.

6 **He shall come down like rain upon the mown grass: as showers that water the earth.**

7 In his days shall **the righteous flourish**; and abundance of peace **so long as the moon endureth**.

8 He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth.

9 They that dwell in the wilderness shall bow before him; and his enemies shall lick the dust.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desired to show His Fear and Favor

Proverbs 19

12 The king's wrath is as the roaring [snarling, growling] of a lion; but his **favour** is as **dew** upon the **grass**.

Favour – OT:7522 > רָצוֹן > ratsown (raw-tsone'); or ratson (raw-tsone'); from OT:7521; delight (especially as shown):

KJV - (be) acceptable (-ance, -ed), delight, desire, favour, (good) pleasure, (ownself., voluntary) will, as ... (what) would.

...from – OT:7521 > רָצָה > ratsah (raw-tsaw'); a primitive root; to be pleased with; specifically, to satisfy a debt:

KJV - (be) accept (-able), accomplish, set affection, approve, consent with, delight (self), enjoy, (be, have a) favour (-able), like, observe, pardon, (be, have, take) please (-ure), reconcileself.

Dew – OT:2919 > טַל > tal (tal); from OT:2926; dew (as covering vegetation):

KJV - dew.

...from – OT:2926 > טָלַל > talal (taw-lal'); a primitive root; properly, to strew over, i.e. (by implication) to cover in or plate (with beams): KJV - cover.

...Fearfulness of God

Hebrews 10

31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

Revelation 21

8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

...Favour of God

Psalms 41

10 But thou, O LORD, be merciful unto me, and raise me up, that I may requite them.

11 By this I know that **thou favourest me**, because mine enemy doth not triumph over me.

Proverbs 16

15 In the light of the king's countenance is life; and his **favour** is as a cloud of the latter rain.

Isaiah 26 ...Favour shown is not Learned of the Wicked

10 Let **favour be shewed to the wicked**, yet will **he not learn righteousness**: in the land of uprightness will he deal unjustly, and will not behold the majesty of the LORD.

Rain upon the just and the unjust! ...the two remain just and unjust!

Matthew 5

45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

Acts 24

15 And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire to Illustrate Desolation

Psalm 102

- 1 Hear my prayer, O LORD, and let my cry come unto thee.
- 2 Hide not thy face from me in the day when I am in trouble; incline thine ear unto me: in the day when I call answer me speedily.
- 3 For my days are consumed like smoke, and my bones are burned as an hearth.
- 4 My heart is smitten, and **withered like grass**; so that I forget to eat my bread.
- 5 By reason of the voice of my groaning my bones cleave to my skin.
- 6 I am like a pelican of the wilderness: I am like an owl of the desert.
- 7 I watch, and am as a sparrow alone upon the house top.
- 8 Mine enemies reproach me all the day; and they that are mad against me are sworn against me.
- 9 For I have eaten ashes like bread, and mingled my drink with weeping.
- 10 Because of thine indignation and thy wrath: for thou hast lifted me up, and cast me down.
- 11 My days are like a shadow that declineth; and I am **withered like grass**.
- 12 But thou, O LORD, shall endure for ever; and thy remembrance unto all generations.

Desire to Rehearse His Destruction

Psalm 37

- 1 Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.
- 2 For they shall soon be **cut down like the grass**, and wither as the green herb.
- 3 Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.

Psalm 92

- 6 A brutish man knoweth not; neither doth a fool understand this.
- 7 When the **wicked spring as the grass**, and when all the workers of iniquity do flourish; it is that **they shall be destroyed** for ever:
- 8 But thou, LORD, art most high for evermore.

James 1 ...Grace ends where mercy ends

- 9 Let the brother of low degree rejoice in that he is exalted:
- 10 But **the rich**, in that he is made low: because **as the flower of the grass he shall pass away**.
- 11 For the sun is no sooner risen with a burning heat, but it **withereth the grass**, and the **flower thereof falleth**, and the **grace of the fashion of it perisheth**: so also shall the rich man fade away in his ways.

James 2

- 13 For **He shall have judgment without mercy**, that hath **shewed no mercy**; and **mercy rejoiceth against judgment**.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire to Tear down and Take up

Psalm 90

- 1 Lord, thou hast been our dwelling place in all generations.
- 2 Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God.
- 3 **Thou turnest man to destruction; and sayest, Return, ye children of men.**
- 4 For a thousand years in thy sight are but as yesterday when it is past, and as a watch in the night.
- 5 Thou **carriest them away as with a flood; they are as a sleep: in the morning they are like grass which groweth up.**
- 6 **In the morning it flourisheth, and groweth up; in the evening it is cut down, and withereth.**
- 7 For we are consumed by thine anger, and by thy wrath are we troubled.
- 8 Thou hast set our iniquities before thee, our secret sins in the light of thy countenance.
- 9 For all **our days are passed away in thy wrath: we spend our years as a tale that is told.**
- 10 The **days of our years are threescore years and ten;** and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is **soon cut off, and we fly away.**
- 11 Who knoweth the power of thine anger? even according to thy fear, so is thy wrath.
- 12 So **teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom.**
- 13 Return, O LORD, how long? and let it repent thee concerning thy servants.
- 14 O satisfy us early with thy mercy; that we may rejoice and be glad all our days.
- 15 Make us glad according to the days wherein thou hast afflicted us, and the years wherein we have seen evil.
- 16 Let thy work appear unto thy servants, and thy glory unto their children.
- 17 And let the beauty of the LORD our God be upon us: and establish thou the work of our hands upon us; yea, the work of our hands establish thou it.

Desire to Reveal the Future all Grass

Revelation 8

- 6 And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.
- 7 The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and **all green grass was burnt up.**
- 8 And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the third part of the sea became blood;

Revelation 9

- 3 And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.
- 4 And it was **commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth,** neither any green thing, neither any tree; but **only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads.**
- 5 And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented five months: and their torment was as the torment of a scorpion, when he striketh a man.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

The end is the same for all flesh...it shall die...but the glorified body unto the righteous remains...

1 Peter 1

13 Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and **hope to the end** for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

14 As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance:

15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

17 And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:

18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

20 Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,

21 Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

23 Being **born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God**, which liveth and abideth for ever.

24 For **all flesh is as grass**, and all the **glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:**

25 **But the word of the Lord endureth for ever.** And **this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.**

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire to Rehearse His Deliverance

Micah 5

6 And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: thus shall he deliver us from the Assyrian, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders.

7 And the **remnant of Jacob** shall be in the midst of many people as a **dew from the LORD**, as the **showers upon the grass**, that tarrieth not for man, nor waiteth for the sons of men.

8 And the remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles in the midst of many people as a lion among the beasts of the forest, as a young lion among the flocks of sheep: who, if he go through, both treadeth down, and teareth in pieces, and none can deliver.

Psalm 147

1 Praise ye the LORD: for it is good to sing praises unto our God; for it is pleasant; and praise is comely.

2 The LORD doth build up Jerusalem: he gathereth together the outcasts of Israel.

3 He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.

4 He telleth the number of the stars; he calleth them all by their names.

5 Great is our Lord, and of great power: his understanding is infinite.

6 The LORD **lifteth up the meek**: he **casteth the wicked down to the ground**.

7 Sing unto the LORD with thanksgiving; sing praise upon the harp unto our God:

8 Who **covereth the heaven with clouds**, who **prepareth rain for the earth**, who **maketh grass to grow upon the mountains**.

9 He **giveth to the beast his food**, and to the young ravens which cry.

10 He **delighteth not in the strength of the horse**: he **taketh not pleasure in the legs of a man**.

11 The LORD **taketh pleasure in them that fear him**, in those that hope in his mercy.

Ezekiel 34

26 And I will make them and the **places round about my hill** a blessing; and **I will cause the shower to come down** in his season; there shall be **showers of blessing**.

Desire to bless His Creation

Zechariah 10

1 Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, **to every one grass in the field**.

2 For the idols have spoken vanity, and the diviners have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because there was no shepherd.

3 Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Desire Protect until the end

Matthew 6

29 And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

30 Wherefore, if God so **clothe the grass** of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, **shall he not much more clothe you**, O ye of little faith?

31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

Romans 8

19 For the earnest expectation of the creature **waiteth for the manifestation** of the sons of God.

20 For the **creature was made subject to vanity**, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope,

21 Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

1 Peter 4

19 Wherefore let **them that suffer according to the will of God commit** the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as **unto a faithful Creator**.

Amos 8

10 And I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation; and I will bring up sackcloth upon all loins, and baldness upon every head; and I will make it as the mourning of an only son, and the end thereof as a bitter day.

11 Behold, **the days come**, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD:

12 And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the LORD, and shall not find it.

Blessed Creation – Day 3

Genesis 1

9 And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so.

10 And God called the dry land Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that it was good.

11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.

12 And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

13 And the evening and the morning were the third day.

Ephesians 1

10 That in the dispensation of the **fulness of times** he might **gather together in one all things in Christ**, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:

Accordingly God which brought forth man out of the dry ground...

...raised up His chosen out of the sea!

...God hath water him and planted in Him the seed...

Genesis 2 ...still it had not rained...

5 And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for **the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth**, and there was not a man to till the ground.

6 But **there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground.**

2 Peter 2

17 These are **wells without water, clouds that are carried with a tempest**; to whom the **mist of darkness is reserved for ever.**

7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a **living soul.**

Isaiah 12

3 Therefore **with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.**
