KJV - (have, make to have) dominion, governor, indeed, reign, (bear, cause to, have) rule (-ing, -r), have power.

<u>Divide</u> – OT:914 > בְּבֵּלְ > badal (baw-dal'); a primitive root; to divide (in variation senses literally or figuratively, separate, distinguish, differ, select, etc.):

KJV - (make, put) difference, divide (asunder), (make) separate (self, -ation), sever (out), utterly.

Darkness – OT:2822 > 7₩Π > choshek (kho-shek'); from OT:2821; the dark; hence (literally)

darkness; figuratively, misery, destruction, death, ignorance, sorrow, wickedness:

KJV - dark (-ness), night, obscurity.

...from – OT:2821 > 기반다 > chashak (khaw-shak'); a primitive root; to be dark (as withholding light); transitively, to darken:

KJV - be black, be (make) dark, darken, cause darkness, be dim, hide.

Ezekiel 32

- **7** And when I shall put thee out, I will cover the heaven, and make the stars thereof dark; I will cover the sun with a cloud, and the moon shall not give her light.
- **8** All the bright lights of heaven will I make dark over thee, and set darkness upon thy land, saith the Lord GOD.
- **9** I will also vex the hearts of many people, when I shall bring thy destruction among the nations, into the countries which thou hast not known.

Amos 5

18 Woe unto you that desire the day of the **LORD**! to what end is it for you? the day of the **LORD** is darkness, and not **light**.

30 And in that day they shall roar against them like the roaring of the sea: and if one look unto the land, behold darkness and sorrow, and the **light** is darkened in the **heaven**s thereof.

Isaiah 13

10 For the stars of heaven and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: the sun shall be darkened in his going forth, and the moon shall not cause her light to shine.

Job 26

- 1 But Job answered and said.
- **2** How hast thou helped him that is without power? how savest thou the arm that hath no strength?
- **3** How hast thou counselled him that hath no wisdom? and how hast thou plentifully declared the thing as it is?
- **4** To whom hast thou uttered words? and whose spirit came from thee?
- **5** Dead things are formed from under the waters, and the inhabitants thereof.
- 6 Hell is naked before him, and destruction hath no covering.
- 7 He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, and hangeth the earth upon nothing.
- 8 He bindeth up the waters in his thick clouds; and the cloud is not rent under them.
- **9** He holdeth back the face of his throne, and spreadeth his cloud upon it.
- 10 He hath compassed the waters with bounds, until the day and night come to an end.
- 11 The pillars of heaven tremble and are astonished at his reproof.
- **12** He divideth the sea with his power, and by his understanding he smiteth through the proud.
- **13** By his spirit he hath garnished the heavens; **his hand hath formed the <u>crooked</u> serpent**.

<u>Crooked</u> – OT:1281 > בְּרֵים > bariyach (baw-ree'-akh); or (shortened) bariach (baw-ree'-akh); from OT:1272; a fugitive, i.e. the serpent (as fleeing), and the constellation by that name: KJV - crooked, noble, piercing.

- ...from OT:1272 >□¬¬¬ > barach (baw-rakh'); a primitive root; to bolt, i.e. figuratively, to flee suddenly:
- KJV chase (away); drive away, fain, flee (away), put to flight, make haste, reach, run away, shoot.
- **14** Lo, these are parts of his ways: but how little a portion is heard of him? but the thunder of his power who can understand?

Isaiah 60

- **18** Violence shall no more be heard in thy land, wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy **walls Salvation**, and thy gates Praise.
- 19 The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but the LORD shall be unto thee an everlasting light, and thy God thy glory.
- **20** Thy sun shall no more go down; neither shall thy moon withdraw itself: for the LORD shall be thine everlasting light, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended.

Revelation 21

23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did **lighten** it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.
