




Approximately 160 years before Cyrus was king over the entire world:

Isaiah 44

²⁸ That saith of Cyrus, **He is my shepherd, and shall perform all my pleasure:** even saying to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be built; and to the temple, Thy foundation shall be laid.

Isaiah 45

¹ Thus saith the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him; and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;

² I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron:

³ And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the LORD, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel.

Daniel 1

²¹ And Daniel continued even unto the first year of king Cyrus [the year 539BC]. 539BC was the 70th year of the captivity that was to be completed by God's people in Babylon. It was the 490th year from the laying of the foundation in the 4th year of Solomon.

Then the first year of the reign of Cyrus, after 70 years in captivity in Babylon....Ezra begins to write in 538BCit is the year of Jubilee for Israel!

Mandate of Cyrus

Ezra 1

¹ Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the Word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he **made a proclamation** throughout all his kingdom, and put it also in writing, saying,

Proclamation – [OT:6963](#) קוֹל **qowl** (kole); or **qol** (kole); from an unused root meaning to call aloud; a voice or sound:

KJV - + aloud, bleating, crackling, cry (+out), fame, lightness, lowing, noise, + hold peace, [pro-] claim, proclamation, + sing, sound, + spark, thunder (-ing), voice, + yell.

Ezra 1

² Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, **The LORD God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and He hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah.**

Charged – [OT:6485](#) פָּקַד **paqad** (paw-kad'); a primitive root; to visit (with friendly or hostile intent); by analogy, to oversee, muster, charge, care for, miss, deposit, etc.:

KJV - appoint, ^xat all, avenge, bestow, (appoint to have the, give a) charge, commit, count, deliver to keep, be empty, enjoin, go see, hurt, do judgment, lack, lay up, look, make, ^xby any means, miss, number, officer, (make) overseer, have (the) oversight, punish, reckon, (call to) remember (-brance), set (over), sum, ^xsurely, visit, want.

Cyrus proclaims the LORD has directed him to allow God's people to return to their homeland after being in captivity for 70 years.

Ezra 1

³ Who is there among you of all His people? his God be with him, and let him go up to Jerusalem, which is in Judah, and build the house of the LORD God of Israel, (He is the God,) which is in Jerusalem.

Ezra 1

⁴ And **whosoever** remaineth in any place where he sojourneth, **let the men of his place help him** with silver, and with gold, and with goods, and with beasts, beside [with, in addition to] the **freewill offering** for the house of God that is in Jerusalem.

Remaineth – [OT:7604](#) שָׁאַר **sha'ar** (shaw-ar'); a primitive root; properly, to swell up, i.e. be (causatively, make) redundant:

KJV - leave, (be) left, let, remain, remnant, reserve, the rest.

Sojourneth – [OT:1481](#) גִּוַר **guwr** (goor); a primitive root; properly, to turn aside from the road (for a lodging or any other purpose), i.e. sojourn (as a guest); also to shrink, fear (as in a strange place); also to gather for hostility (as afraid):

KJV - abide, assemble, be afraid, dwell, fear, gather (together), inhabitant, remain, sojourn, stand in awe, (be) stranger, ^xsurely.

Freewill offering – [OT:5071](#) נְדָבָה **nedabah** (ned-aw-baw'); from [OT:5068](#); properly (abstractly) spontaneity, or (adjectively) spontaneous; also (concretely) a spontaneous or (by inference, in plural) abundant gift:

KJV - free (-will) offering, freely, plentiful, voluntary (-ily, offering), willing (-ly), offering).

Israel Raised up

Ezra 1

⁵ Then rose up the chief of the fathers of Judah and Benjamin, and the priests, and the Levites, with all **them whose spirit God had raised**, to go up to **build the house of the LORD** which is **in Jerusalem**.

Spirit - [OT:7307](#) רוּחַ **ruwach** (roo'-akh); from [OT:7306](#); wind; by resemblance breath, i.e. a sensible (or even violent) exhalation; figuratively, life, anger, unsubstantiality; by extension, a region of the sky; by resemblance spirit, but only of a rational being (including its expression and functions):

KJV - air, anger, blast, breath, ^xcool, courage, mind, ^xquarter, ^xside, spirit ([-ual]), tempest, ^xvain, ([whirl-]) wind (-y).

Raised – [OT:5782](#) עָוַר **uwr** (oor); a primitive root [rather identical with [OT:5783](#) through the idea of opening the eyes]; to wake (literally or figuratively):

KJV - (awake (-n, up), lift up (self), ^xmaster, raise (up), stir up (self).

Only God will fulfill His will and Only God can fulfill His will!

Ezra 1

⁶ And all they that were about them **strengthened their hands** [seized] with vessels of silver, with gold, with goods, and with beasts, and with precious things, beside all that was willingly offered.

Ezra 1

⁷ Also **Cyrus the king brought forth the vessels of the house of the LORD**, which **Nebuchadnezzar had brought forth out of Jerusalem**, and had put them in the house of his gods;

Ezra 1 ...identified, valued, numbered, returned to Zerubbabel

⁸ Even those did Cyrus king of Persia bring forth by the hand of **Mithredath the treasurer**, and **numbered them** unto **Sheshbazzar [Zerubbabel], the prince of Judah**.

Ezra 1

⁹ And this is the number of them: thirty [30] chargers [basins] of gold, a thousand [1000] chargers of silver, nine and twenty [29] knives,

Ezra 1

¹⁰ Thirty [30] basons of gold, silver basons of a second sort four hundred and ten [410], and other vessels a thousand [1000].

Ezra 1

¹¹ All the vessels of gold and of silver were five thousand and four hundred [5400]. All **these did Sheshbazzar [Zerubbabel] bring up with them of the captivity that were brought up from Babylon unto Jerusalem**.

God will never release His claim for what is HIS!

Ezra 2

¹ Now these are the **children of the province** that **went up out of the captivity**, of those which had been **carried away**, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had **carried away unto Babylon, and came again unto Jerusalem and Judah, every one unto his city**;

Province – [OT:4082](#) מְדִינָה **mediynah** (med-ee-naw'); from [OT:1777](#); properly, a judgeship, i.e. jurisdiction; by implication, a district (as ruled by a judge); generally, a region: **KJV** - (X every) province.

Captivity – [OT:7628](#) שְׁבִי' **shebiy** (sheb-ee'); from [OT:7618](#); exiled; captured; as noun, exile (abstractly or concretely and collectively); by extension, booty: **KJV** - captive (-ity), prisoners, *take away, that was taken.

Carried away – [OT:1473](#) גּוֹלָה **gowlah** (go-law'); or (shortened) **golah** (go-law'); active participle feminine of [OT:1540](#); exile; concretely and collectively exiles: -carried away), captive (-ity), removing.

² Which **came with Zerubbabel**: Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mizpar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel:

⁶¹ And of the **children of the priests**: the children of Habaiah, the children of Koz, the children of Barzillai; which took a wife of the daughters of Barzillai the Gileadite, and was called after their name:

Ezra 2

⁶² **These sought their register** among those that were **reckoned by genealogy**, but they were **not found**: therefore were they, as polluted, **put from the priesthood**.

Reckoned by genealogy – [OT:3187](#) **יָחָשׁ** **yachas** (yaw-khas'); a primitive root; to sprout; used only as denominative from [OT:3188](#); to enroll by pedigree: **KJV** - (number after, number throughout the) genealogy (to be reckoned), be reckoned by genealogies.

Polluted – [OT:1351](#) **גָּאֵל** **ga'al** (gaw-al'); a primitive root, [rather identified with [OT:1350](#), through the idea of freeing, i.e. repudiating]; to soil or (figuratively) desecrate: **KJV** - defile, pollute, stain.

Ezra 2

⁶³ And the Tirshatha said unto them, that they **should not eat of the most holy things**, till there stood up a **priest with Urim and with Thummim**.

Urim - [OT:224](#) **אֲרִימִים** **'Uwriym** (oo-reem'); plur of [OT:217](#); lights; Urim, the oracular brilliancy of the figures in the high-priest's breastplate: **KJV** - Urim.

Thummim - [OT:8550](#) **תֻּמִּימִים** **Tummiym** (toom-meem'); plural of [OT:8537](#); perfections, i.e. (techn.) one of the epithets of the objects in the high-priest's breastplate as an emblem of complete Truth: **KJV** - Thummim.

The Whole Congregation

Ezra 2

⁶⁴ The **whole congregation** together was **forty and two thousand three hundred and threescore [42360]**,

Congregation – [OT:6951](#) **קָהָל** **qahal** (kaw-hawl'); from [OT:6950](#); assemblage (usually concretely): **KJV** - assembly, company, congregation, multitude.

The Servants

⁶⁵ Beside their **servants and their maids**, of whom there were **seven thousand three hundred thirty and seven [7337]**: and there were among them **two hundred [200] singing men and singing women**.

⁶⁶ Their **horses** were seven hundred thirty and six [736]; their **mules**, two hundred forty and five [245];

⁶⁷ Their **camels**, four hundred thirty and five [435]; their **asses**, six thousand seven hundred and twenty [6720].

The Chiefs

Ezra 2

⁶⁸ And some of the **chief of the fathers**, when they came to the house of the LORD which is at Jerusalem, **offered freely** for the house of God to set it up in his place:

The Treasures

Ezra 2

⁶⁹ They **gave after their ability** unto the treasure of the work threescore and one thousand [61000] drams of gold, and five thousand [5000] pound of silver, and one hundred [100] priests' garments.

61000 drams = 3812.5 ounces @\$1600/ounce \$6.1mil

Ezra 2 ...summary

⁷⁰ So the priests, and the Levites, and some of the people, and the singers, and the porters, and the Nethinims, dwelt in their cities, and all Israel in their cities.

¹ And when the **seventh month** was come, and the children of Israel were in the cities, the **people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem.**

Romans 12

¹⁶ **Be of the same mind one toward another.** Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

² Fulfil ye my joy, that ye **be likeminded**, having the **same love**, being **of one accord**, of **one mind.**

Build the Altar

Ezra 3

² Then stood up **Jeshua** the son of Jozadak, and his brethren the priests, and **Zerubbabel** the son of Shealtiel, and his brethren, and **builded the altar of the God of Israel**, to offer burnt offerings thereon, as it is written in the law of **Moses the man of God.**

Burnt offerings

Ezra 3

³ And they set the altar upon his bases; for fear was upon them because of the people of those countries: and they offered burnt offerings thereon unto the LORD, even burnt offerings morning and evening.

Feast of tabernacles

Ezra 3

⁴ They **kept also the feast of tabernacles**, as it is written, and **offered the daily burnt offerings** by number, according to the custom, as the duty of every day required;

Freewill offerings

Ezra 3

⁵ And afterward offered the **continual burnt offering**, both of the new moons, and of all the set feasts of the LORD that were consecrated, and of every one that **willingly offered a freewill offering unto the LORD.**

Postponed foundation

Ezra 3

⁶ From the first day of the seventh month began they to **offer burnt offerings** unto the LORD. But the **foundation of the temple of the LORD was not yet laid.**

⁷They gave money also unto the **masons**, and to the **carpenters**; and meat, and drink, and oil, unto them of Zidon, and to them of Tyre, to bring cedar trees from Lebanon to the sea of Joppa, **according to the grant [rishyown - permission to take leave] that they had of Cyrus king of Persia.**

Ezra 3

⁸ Now in the **second year** of their coming unto the house of God at Jerusalem, in the second month, began **Zerubbabel** the son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and the **remnant** of their brethren the priests and the Levites, and all they that were come out of the captivity unto Jerusalem; and appointed the **Levites, from twenty [20] years old and upward**, to **set forward the work of the house of the LORD**.

Direction

Ezra 3

⁹ Then stood Jeshua with his sons and his brethren, Kadmiel and his sons, the sons of Judah, together, to **set forward the workmen in the house of God**: the sons of Henadad, with their sons and their brethren the Levites.

Priests minister

Ezra 3

¹⁰ And when the **builders laid the foundation** of the temple of the LORD, they set **the priests in their apparel with trumpets**, and the Levites the sons of Asaph with **cymbals**, to **praise the LORD**, after the ordinance of David king of Israel.

Worship

Ezra 3

¹¹ And they **sang together by course in praising and giving thanks** unto the LORD; because **He is good**, for **His mercy endureth for ever** toward Israel. And all the **people shouted** with a great shout, when they **praised the LORD**, because **the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid**.

Joyful

Ezra 3 elders had see the 1st temple

¹² But many of the priests and Levites and chief of the fathers, who were **ancient men**, that had **seen the first house, when the foundation of this house was laid** before their eyes, **wept** with a loud voice; and many **shouted aloud for joy**:

From the destruction of Jerusalem (burned and leveled) until the completion of the 2nd temple of Ezra was 70 years

¹³ So that **the people** could not discern the noise of the **shout of joy** from the **noise of the weeping** of the people: for the people **shouted with a loud shout**, and the **noise was heard afar off**.

Ezra 4

¹ Now when the **adversaries of Judah and Benjamin** heard that the children of the **captivity** build the temple unto the LORD God of Israel;

Adversaries – [OT:6862](#) **צָר** **tsar** (tsar); or **tsar** (tsawr); from [OT:6887](#); narrow; (as a noun) a tight place (usually figuratively, i.e. trouble); also a pebble (as in [OT:6864](#)); (transitive) an opponent (as crowding):

KJV - adversary, afflicted (-tion), anguish, close, distress, enemy, flint, foe, narrow, small, sorrow, strait, tribulation, trouble.

Captivity – [OT:1473](#) **גֹּלוּל** **gowlah** (go-law'); or (shortened) **golah** (go-law'); active participle feminine of [OT:1540](#); exile; concretely and collectively exiles: -carried away), captive (-ity), removing.

Ezra 4

² Then they came to Zerubbabel, and to the chief of the fathers, and said unto them, **Let us build with you: for we seek your God, as ye do; and we do sacrifice unto him since the days of Esarhaddon king of Assur, which brought us up hither.**

Ezra 4

³ But Zerubbabel, and Jeshua, and the rest of the chief of the fathers of Israel, said unto them, **Ye have nothing to do with us to build an house unto our God; but we ourselves together will build unto the LORD God of Israel, as king Cyrus the king of Persia hath commanded us.**

Ezra 4

⁴ Then the people of the land weakened the hands of the people of Judah, and troubled [agitated or cause concern] them in building,

⁵ And hired counsellors against them, to frustrate their purpose, all the days of Cyrus king of Persia, even until the reign of Darius king of Persia [18 years].

⁶ And in the reign of **Ahasuerus** [see Esther], in the beginning of his reign, **wrote they** unto him an **accusation against the inhabitants of Judah and Jerusalem.**

Note:

Probably the Ahasuerus [Hystaspes] of Ezra and Esther and Daniel

Daniel 9





Weeping – [OT:1058](#) בָּכָה **bakah** (baw-kaw'); a primitive root; to weep; generally to bemoan:

KJV - ^x at all, bewail, complain, make lamentation, ^x more, mourn, ^x sore, ^x with tears, weep.

Congregation – [OT:6951](#) קָהָל **qahal** (kaw-hawl'); from [OT:6950](#); assemblage (usually concretely): **KJV** - assembly, company, congregation, multitude.

² And Shechaniah the son of Jehiel, one of the sons of Elam, answered and said unto Ezra, We have trespassed against our God, and have taken strange wives of the people of the land: yet now **there is hope** in Israel concerning this thing.

Trespassed – [OT:4603](#) מָעַל **ma`al** (maw-al'); a primitive root; properly, to cover up; used only figuratively, to act covertly, i.e. treacherously:

KJV - transgress, (commit, do a) trespass (-ing).

Strange – [OT:5237](#) נִכְרִי **nokriy** (nok-ree'); from [OT:5235](#) (second form); strange, in a variety of degrees and applications (foreign, non-relative, adulterous, different, wonderful): **KJV** - alien, foreigner, outlandish, strange (-r, woman).

Ezra 10

³ Now therefore let us make a covenant with our God to **put away all the wives, and** such as are **born of them [children]**, according to the counsel of my Lord, and of those that **tremble at the commandment** of our God; and let it be done **according to the law**.

Covenant – [OT:1285](#) בְּרִית **beriyth** (ber-eeth'); from [OT:1262](#) (in the sense of cutting [like [OT:1254](#)]); a compact (because made by passing between pieces of flesh): -confederacy, [con-] feder [-ate], covenant, league.

Counsel – [OT:6098](#) עֵצָה **etsah** (ay-tsaw'); from [OT:3289](#); advice; by implication, plan; also prudence: **KJV** - advice, advisement, counsel (l- [or]), purpose.

Matter – [OT:1697](#) דָּבָר **dabar** (daw-baw'); from [OT:1696](#); a word; by implication, a matter (as spoken of) or thing; adverbially, a cause:

KJV - act, advice, affair, answer, ^x any such (thing), because of, book, business, care, case, cause, certain rate, ⁺ chronicles, commandment, ^x commune (-ication), ⁺ concern [-ing], ⁺ confer, counsel, ⁺ dearth, decree, deed, ^x disease, due, duty, effect, ⁺ eloquent, errand, [evil favouredness-], ⁺ glory, ⁺ harm, hurt, ⁺ iniquity, ⁺ judgment, language, ⁺ lying, manner, matter, message, [no] thing, oracle, ^x ought, ^x parts, ⁺ pertaining, ⁺ please, portion, ⁺ power, promise, provision, purpose, question, rate, reason, report, request, ^x (as hast) said, sake, saying, sentence, ⁺ sign, ⁺ so, some [uncleanness], somewhat to say, ⁺ song, speech, ^x spoken, talk, task, ⁺ that, ^x there done, thing (concerning), thought, ⁺ thus, tidings, what [-soever], ⁺ wherewith, which, word, work.

Good courage – [OT:2388](#) חָזַק **chazaq** (khaw-zak'); a primitive root; to fasten upon; hence, to seize, be strong (figuratively, courageous, causatively strengthen, cure, help, repair, fortify), obstinate; to bind, restrain, conquer:

KJV - aid, amend, ^x calker, catch, cleave, confirm, be constant, constrain, continue, be of good (take) courage (-ous, -ly), encourage (self), be established, fasten, force, fortify, make hard, harden, help, (lay) hold (fast), lean, maintain, play the man, mend, become (wax) mighty, prevail, be recovered, repair, retain, seize, be (wax) sore, strengthen (self), be stout, be (make, shew, wax) strong (-er), be sure, take (hold), be urgent, behave self valiantly, withstand.

Proclamation – [OT:6908](#) קָבַץ **qabats** (kaw-bats'); a primitive root; to grasp, i.e. collect: **KJV** - assemble (selves), gather (bring) (together, selves together, up), heap, resort, ^x surely, take up.

Captivity – [OT:1473](#) גּוֹלָה **gowlah** (go-law'); or (shortened) **golah** (go-law'); active participle feminine of [OT:1540](#); exile; concretely and collectively exiles: -carried away), captive (-ity), removing.

The time limit

⁸ And that **whosoever would not come within three days**, according to the counsel of the princes and the elders, all his **substance should be forfeited**, and himself **separated from the congregation** of those that had been carried away [exiled].

Forfeited – [OT:2763](#) חָרַם **charam** (khaw-ram'); a primitive root; to seclude; specifically (by a ban) to devote to religious uses (especially destruction); physical and reflexive, to be blunt as to the nose:

KJV - make accursed, consecrate, (utterly) destroy, devote, forfeit, have a flat nose, utterly (slay, make away).

Separated – [OT:914](#) בָּדַל **badal** (baw-dal'); a primitive root; to divide (in variation senses literally or figuratively, separate, distinguish, differ, select, etc.):

KJV - (make, put) difference, divide (asunder), (make) separate (self, -ation), sever (out), ^x utterly.

Congregation – [OT:6951](#) קָהָל **qahal** (kaw-hawl'); from [OT:6950](#); assemblage (usually concretely): **KJV** - assembly, company, congregation, multitude.

Trembling – [OT:7460](#) רָעַד **ra`ad** (raw-ad'); a primitive root: to shudder (more or less violently): **KJV** - tremble.

Great rain – [OT:1653](#) גֶּשֶׁם **geshem** (gheh'-shem); from [OT:1652](#); a shower: **KJV** - rain, shower.

Under stalwart leadership

Transgressed – [OT:4603](#) מָעַל **ma`al** (maw-al'); a primitive root; properly, to cover up; used only figuratively, to act covertly, i.e. treacherously: **KJV** - transgress, (commit, do a) trespass (-ing).

Strange – [OT:5237](#) נֹכְרִי **nokriy** (nok-ree'); from [OT:5235](#) (second form); strange, in a variety of degrees and applications (foreign, non-relative, adulterous, different, wonderful): **KJV** - alien, foreigner, outlandish, strange (-r, woman).

Increase – [OT:3254](#) יָצַף **yacaph** (yaw-saf'); a primitive root; to add or augment (often adverbial, to continue to do a thing):

KJV - add, ^x again, ^x any more, ^x cease, ^x come more, ⁺ conceive again, continue, exceed, ^x further, ^x gather together, get more, give more-over, ^x henceforth, increase (more and more), join, ^x longer (bring, do, make, much, put), ^x (the, much, yet) more (and more), proceed (further), prolong, put, be [stronger-], ^x yet, yield.

Trespass – [OT:819](#) אֲשָׁמָה **'ashmah** (ash-maw'); feminine of [OT:817](#); guiltiness, a fault, the presentation of a sin-offering:

KJV - offend, sin, (cause of) trespass (-ing, offering).

Confession – [OT:8426](#) תָּדַח **towdah** (to-daw'); from [OT:3034](#); properly, an extension of the hand, i.e. (by implication) avowal, or (usually) adoration; specifically, a choir of worshippers:

KJV - confession, (sacrifice of) praise, thanks (-giving, offering).

Pleasure – [OT:7522](#) רָצוֹן **ratsown** (raw-tsone'); or **ratson** (raw-tsone'); from [OT:7521](#); delight (especially as shown):

KJV - (be) acceptable (-ance, -ed), delight, desire, favour, (good) pleasure, (oneself,, voluntary) will, as ... (what) would.

Separate – [OT:914](#) בָּדַל **badal** (baw-dal'); a primitive root; to divide (in variation senses literally or figuratively, separate, distinguish, differ, select, etc.):

KJV - (make, put) difference, divide (asunder), (make) separate (self, -ation), sever (out), ^xutterly.

Strange – [OT:5237](#) נֹכְרִי **nokriy** (nok-ree'); from [OT:5235](#) (second form); strange, in a variety of degrees and applications (foreign, non-relative, adulterous, different, wonderful): **KJV** - alien, foreigner, outlandish, strange (-r, woman).

Transgressed – [OT:6586](#) פָּשַׁע **pasha`** (paw-shah'); a primitive root [identical with [OT:6585](#) through the idea of expansion]; to break away (from just authority), i.e. trespass, apostatize, quarrel: **KJV** - offend, rebel, revolt, transgress (-ion, -or).

Strange – [OT:5237](#) נִכְרִי **nokriy** (nok-ree'); from [OT:5235](#) (second form); strange, in a variety of degrees and applications (foreign, non-relative, adulterous, different, wonderful): **KJV** - alien, foreigner, outlandish, strange (-r, woman).

Fierce – [OT:2740](#) חַרוֹן **charown** (khaw-rone'); or (shortened) **charon** (khaw-rone'); from [OT:2734](#); a burning of anger:

KJV - sore displeasure, fierce (-ness), fury, (fierce) wrath (-ful).

Wrath – [OT:639](#) אַף **'aph** (af); from [OT:599](#); properly, the nose or nostril; hence, the face, and occasionally a person; also (from the rapid breathing in passion) ire:

KJV - anger (-gry), * before, countenance, face, * forebearing, forehead, * [long-] suffering, nose, nostril, snout, * worthy, wrath.

From us – [OT:4480](#) מִן **min** (min); or **minniy** (min-nee'); or **minney** (constructive plural) (min-nay'); ([Isa 30:11](#)); for [OT:4482](#); properly, a part of; hence (prepositionally), from or out of in many senses (as follows):

KJV - above, after, among, at, because of, by (reason of), from (among), in, * neither, * nor, (out) of, over, since, * then, through, * whether, with.

¹⁵ Only Jonathan the son of Asahel and Jahaziah the son of Tikvah were employed about this matter: and Meshullam and Shabbethai the Levite helped them.

¹⁶ And the **children of the captivity did so [as they said]**. And Ezra the priest, with certain chief of the fathers, after the house of their fathers, and all of them by their names, were **separated**, and sat down in the first day of the tenth month to **examine the matter**.

KJV - ask, * at all, care for, * diligently, inquire, make inquisition, [neco-] mancer, question, require, search, seek [for, out], * surely.

Made an end – OT:3615 **כָּלַח** (*kalah* (kaw-law'); a primitive root; to end, whether intransitive (to cease, be finished, perish) or transitived (to complete, prepare, consume): - accomplish, cease, consume (away), determine, destroy (utterly), be (when ... were) done, (be an) end (of), expire, (cause to) fail, faint, finish, fulfil, **x** fully, **x** have, leave (off), long, bring to pass, wholly reap, make clean riddance, spend, quite take away, waste.
