"After Tantur, the daily readings from both the Old and the New Testament, set in the culture, history and geography of the 'Holy Land', have taken on a new life. Places, events, feasts, names are no

longer just strange words or things I read about in a book – they now connect to experiences I had in Tantur, and so have become more alive!"

In the 1960s, Pope Paul VI along with Protestant and Orthodox scholars envisioned an institute that would be designed for scholars to live in residence and to pursue their individual research in a community setting. The program is not a set of academic courses. However from



time to time scholars meet in colloquia to discuss each other's work.



Since then Tantur has developed several different Programs and Special Courses to serve those seeking to deepen their understanding of this land, its history, its culture, its people and their own faith.

The Continuing Education Programs are designed for those who are members of a Christian community, whether as priests, pastors, educators or lay people. These programs range in length from three weeks (the Easter Encounter) to three months. The average program size is between 15 to 20 participants.


