MANOS DEL URUGUAY

SIZE

162cm (64") long. 20cm (8") wide.

MATERIALS

Manos Del Uruguay Silk Blend Fino (70% Extra Fine Merino / 30% Silk), 450m/490yds per 100g),

1 x 100g hank MC plus 1 Miniskein Set.

Shown in 414 Ivory Letter Opener (MC) with kit 4 Dorothea

(431 Chemise [CC1], 424 Guilt [CC2], 430 Filigree [CC3], 407 Velvet Pincushion [CC4], 423 Tincture [CC5]).

4mm (US 6) 80cm circular needle or longer, or size to obtain gauge

Waste yarn for provisional cast-on (optional) and to hold large number of stitches

Ring marker

2 Stitch Holders

TENSION

22 sts by 48 rows in 10cm square in Garter Stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

CO: cast on

K: knit

Ndl: needle

Rep: repeat

RS: right side

Sl: slip

St(s): stitch(es)

Wyif: with yarn in front

STITCH GUIDE

Block Stripe Pattern

Rows 1-24: With MC, sl1 wyif, k to end. Do not cut MC.

Rows 25-26: With CC, sl1 wyif, k to end. Cut CC. Rep rows 1-26 for Block Stripe Pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

CO (provisionally, if you like) 27 sts.

Blocks 1-20: Work 20 reps of Block Stripe Pattern, using CCs in order (i.e., CC1 for first rep; CC2 for



second rep; CC3 for third rep; etc.). End having just worked 2 rows with CC5.

Block 21: With MC, work rows 1-24 of Block Stripe Pattern. Put sts on holder, and cut MC.

Block 22: Looking at RS of work, rotate it 90° clockwise. With CC1, pick up and knit 1 st in each slipped st along left edge of work – 272 sts. Next row: S11 wyif, k to end. Cut CC. With MC, k 32 rows, always slipping the first st wyif. Cut MC and put sts on waste yarn to hold.

Block 23: Looking at RS of work, rotate it 90° clockwise. With CC3, pick up and knit 1 st in each slipped st along left edge of work, then 1 st in each CO st (or ravel out your provisional CO and return sts to left ndl, then knit them). 43 sts. Next row: S11 wyif, k to end. Cut CC. With MC, k 24 rows, always slipping first st wyif. Cut MC and put sts on holder or waste yarn.

Block 24: Return held sts from end of Block 21 to ndl. With CC1, s11 wyif, k to end of row, then pick up and k 1 st in each slipped st along right edge of Block 22 – 44 sts. K 25 rows, always slipping the first st wyif. Cut CC1.

Block 25: With CC2, k 26 rows, always slipping the first st wyif. Cut CC2.

Block 26: Rep Block 25, using CC3.

Block 27: Rep Block 26, using CC4.

Block 28: Using CC5, k 25 rows, always slipping the first st wyif.

Border: Rotate the work 90° clockwise. Continuing with CC5, pick up and knit 1 st in each slipped st along left edge of blocks 28-24 (64 sts), then return held sts from Block 22 to left end of ndl and knit them (272 more sts), then pick up and knit 1 st in each slipped st along edge of Block 23 (13 more sts). Rotate the work another 90° clockwise and return held sts from Block 23 to left end of ndl, then knit across them (43 more sts). Rotate the work another 90° clockwise and pick up and knit 13 sts along edge of Block 23, then 13 sts along edge of each of blocks 1-20, then 12 sts along edge of Block 21, then 13 sts along edge of each of blocks 24-27, then 12 sts along edge of Block 28. 785 sts, give or take. Place marker to show beginning of round. Purl 1 round, then bind off knitwise.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.
