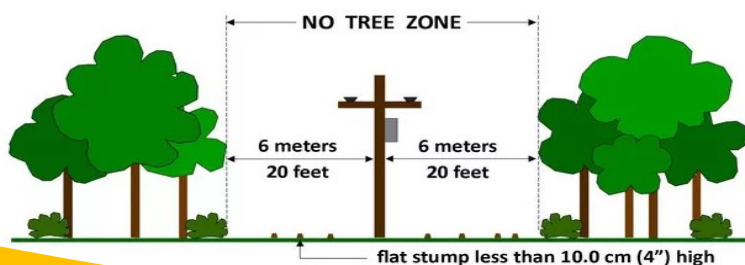
Summer Energy Saving Tips

Stay *COOL* this summer with great energy savings!

1. Avoid cooking inside on the hottest days, and try barbequing outside instead! This will help cut down on warm air in the home and lower energy consumption!
2. Dry your laundry outdoors. Line drying uses zero energy, and keeps your laundry smelling fantastic!
3. Keep the blinds and windows closed during the day and open at night. This is a way to keep your home a little cooler in the evening.
4. Make sure your fans are spinning clockwise. This allows the air to be pushed down into the room causing a breeze to cool you off during those hot summer days.

Vegetation Management

If trees or vegetation interfere with a power line or a transformer pole, trimming or complete removal of the trees or vegetation may be necessary. Our patrols are ongoing, however we cannot be everywhere at the same time. If you see vegetation close to an overhead primary power line, please help us by calling our office at 780-349-3655.
