Principal's Remarks:

Volunteer Spot Update: The volunteer website is working very well. An email was sent to families who indicated they would be able to volunteer on International Night (November 3rd) but have not yet signed up. There is available seating in the gymnasium for 410 guests.

Wish List:

Each Department provided a WISH list.
