HECTORS PRIDE broke alertly, got engaged in a pace dispute with the runner up despite being brushed several times in the shadow of the starting gate, raced teamed up with rival from the inside, placed to a firm hold down the backstretch, with the nemesis being rated too during the honest opening split, began to shake free of MARBLE FALLS as the half was being completed, set foot into the lane with that opponent no longer latched on and had the rider go to work, steadily lengthened the winning margin, primarily being strongly hand pumped crossing the wire. MARBLE FALLS sparred two to three wide with the winner, proved no match once they entered the stretch, but managed to still show enough to earn a second best designation. GIANT FOX sent onto the inside route coming to the end of the backstretch, swung four wide into upper stretch, got straightened away and rallied well enough to get up for the show. BECAUSE HE CAN travelled in the two path on the turn, was already being called upon by the five-sixteenths pole, angled five wide into the stretch, mustered up a mild response to grab the last major check. DANCE CHAMPION got involved in a three-way exchange of light bumps soon after the start, departed the backstretch having been placed into the two path, spun into the stretch slighter wider than on the turn, lacked the needed response. COPERNICUS loosely drafted behind the winner on the turn and faltered. T SIZZLE underwent a series of light bumps soon after the break, left the three-eighths pole three wide, the widest of all, began the final furlong six wide, once again the widest of all, tired.
