COME DANCING moved up into a forward position after the field had been sent off and running, hitched up the front runners after the first fraction had been finalized, was in reserve, travelling in the three path, forcing the issue as the outermost of a threesome during the run around of the bend, was the last of that trio to have its pilot commit to stronger handling, this occurring in the shadow of the three-sixteenths pole, forged to control despite lugging in for a furlong beginning at that station, was comfortably in the clear when geared down for the last seventy yards. MINIT TO STARDOM cut over to the inside after an apparent clean getaway, disputed the pace from path two, went about the task from between rivals once the winner drew up to her late on the backstretch, got called upon settling in at the top of the lane, vied with winner one on one, not intimidated as COME DANCING was lugging in herself during their tussle, proved no match in the last eighth. MAJESTIC REASON rode the rail, was set down approaching the three-eighths pole, angled three wide into the lane and went on to secure the show. CARRERA CAT the quickest springing from the gate, retained a narrow advantage, got guided over to the inside route, showed the way pressed by the second place finisher, firmly rated during the initial stages, had the winner add herself to pace picture a panel into the contest, ventured onward leading by a slim margin as the top twosome kept up the pressure, was put to a drive approaching the quarter pole, but all for naught, having already been displaced as the leader by this juncture, backed away down the stretch. JC'S SHOOTING STAR off a half length the slowest, was put to a hand ride just about from the get-go, remained detached from the others, was two wide entering the turn and four wide exiting it, wound up trailing throughout.
