**Footnotes**

MADISON BLUES raced close up inside, briefly waited for room in upper stretch, rallied on the rail, dug in gamely and edged away late. LUCKYSTRIKEDELCOCO set the pace on the inside, dueled on the far turn, shook free, dug in gamely past midstretch and yielded grudgingly. LOON RIVER raced off the pace, three wide on the backside, moved up four wide on the far turn and rallied mildly outside. ARABIAN QUEEN raced off the pace inside, saved ground on the far turn and lacked a late bid. ZOUZOU raced three wide early, stalked three wide, continued three wide on the far turn and finished evenly. WELL COMPOSED pressed the pace, bid on the turn and weakened. SCOTTISH SWEETIE was steadied entering the first turn, raced off the rail, off the pace and made a belated gain on the rail. SHAKESPERIAN DREAM trailed the field, raced on the rail in the stretch and failed to threaten. ENIGMA steadied entering the first turn, raced between foes and tired. BAAL PERAZIM was off a bit slow, raced four wide early, stalked four wide, drifted out wide at the quarter pole and gave way.
