SUPER ALLISON was intially lightly hand urged to stay within range of the front runners down the backstretch, left the half mile pole three wide, crept up towards the front runners from that station, arrived at the end of the bend leading by a narrow margin, spun into the stretch, hard held on the right, counteracting an attempt to lug in, finally do so deep into the furlong grounds after the rider released the previously-described hol, left the eighth pole holding its largest advantage, squandered some it belatedly yet stayed sufficiently in the clear. PICCO UNO sat within range of the front runners from the two path, swung three wide into the stretch, was forced to steady for a jump reacting to TRUE CHARM changing course right around the three-sixteenths marker, shied out slightly too, got going again in short order and rallied willingly to garner the place. CATS HALO broke alertly and kept the advantage, cut over to the rail, argued inside two others from the top of the turn to the five-sixteenths pole before relinquishing then steadily backed away. CHEERING FOR AL saved ground early, was put to a strong drive angling two wide into the stretch, made no headway. EIGHTH COMMANDMENT made solid contact with the left side of the gate after it was sprung open, was three wide entering the turn and four wide exiting it, made no impact. TRUE CHARM sparred early for command from the two path, kept up the bid but positioned in the middle of foes beginning from the half mile pole, grabbed a narrow and short-lived advantage as the half was being reached,set foot into the lane trailing narrowly, altered course to the outside in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, crossing over close enough to the second place so as to cause its rider steady the mount for a stride in addition to shifting slighter wider itself, faltered in the final furlong. LADY IN SHADES came inward after striking the left side of the starting gate, set foot onto the turn from the two path, was placed four wide at the head of the stretch, had no offering.
