

From the Pastor

So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out.

– Romans 12:1-2 (The Message)

The Christian life is an exercise in service and selflessness. As Paul writes in his letter to the church in Rome, God will help us transform our everyday lives into offerings that can be used in the service of God and other people.

In worship on August 24th, the congregation had the opportunity complete a spiritual gifts inventory. This tool helps identify the God-given gifts that each of us has. It is accompanied by a “translator” document that can help discover which specific tasks of ministry are best served by people with particular kinds of spiritual gifts.

So, for example, if someone is very good at woodworking or painting, that person might have the spiritual gift of “skilled craft” and may be a good person to invite to join the Tuesday maintenance group. If someone loves to read and is good at remembering details (like whether Titus is in the Old or New Testament), that person might have the spiritual gift of “knowledge” and might be a good person to invite to serve as Sunday School teacher, or as participant in an adult Bible study.

If you did not have a chance to complete one of these inventories, I encourage you to do so! Copies are available in the church office, and there is a shoebox for submitting completed inventories, so that they remain confidential. This fall, we will spend more time talking about spiritual gifts, and how we can use our gifts as individuals and as a community for the benefit of God and others.
