

## From the Pastor

*Then [Jesus] said to them, "Give ... to God the things that are God's.*

- Matthew 22:21

In recent weeks, Cooksville Lutheran Church has been discussing various possibilities for financial viability. Our congregation passed a budget at our last annual meeting that is not sustainable at the current level of financial support. Monetary offerings are about \$2000 shy of expenses every month. While we've been keeping expenses down, we can't cut all costs. Even the extra financial boost that we get from Fall Festival only covers a few months of insufficient giving.

Our congregation has been a witness to God's work in Cooksville for many years. For much of that time, we relied on large farming families as our primary means of support. Today, families in the US today rarely have more than 2 children. Whereas in the past, one invitation to a family could result in 10 more members to our congregation, these days, it might take 4 invitations to achieve the same amount of congregational growth.

This means that, in order to keep our congregation's ministry active, and in order to achieve any kind of growth, we all need to work harder. We need to find new and creative ways of supporting the financial needs of this congregation. Some suggestions and examples are on the following pages.

This also means that we need to be willing to invite others into our church community. If you know anyone who does not have a church home, invite them to try ours out! Talk about church with your coworkers or your book club or your in-laws. If they show an interest in learning more, invite them to join you here for worship next week.

As Jesus reminds us, our job is to give to God what belongs to God. That includes our selves, our time, and our possessions, as we remember in worship with the Offering Prayer. Our current and most pressing need as a congregation is to live out that prayer every week, and to share our church community with others so that they may join us.

### **Financial Support**

Congregational ministry requires prayer, commitment, volunteer time, and financial resources. Cooksville Lutheran is rich in the first few assets, but we have a serious shortfall in our financial resources. Offerings in September totaled \$7,095.50. The annual budget approved by the congregation at our last annual meeting requires a monthly income of \$11,156.91. This budget provides for a minimum of expenses, so the only place to eliminate spending is in personnel. The simplest way to bring our budget into balance is through an increase in monetary offerings. Please consider supporting Cooksville Lutheran Church with an extra financial gift this month. In addition, alternative methods of support are suggested below and on the following page.

### **Automated Giving**

Having your offering deducted monthly from your checking account is good for you, and good for the church! It can be easy to forget to bring your offering to worship, so automated giving helps you follow through on your commitment to financially support the ministry of Cooksville Lutheran. Our congregation relies on regular offerings to keep our doors open. Automated giving allows us to count on your support even if you are traveling or ill, or if worship must be cancelled. Cooksville Lutheran uses a secure program supported by Thrivent to facilitate the transfer of money from your bank account to the church.
