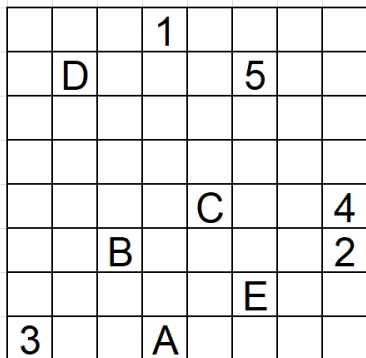


# Puzzles and Quizzes - Day 5

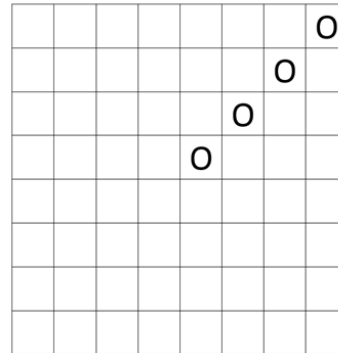
## Easier Problem
