- + Write a short letter in simple English. Be sure to keep the letter encouraging, not dwelling on their hardships or what they do not have. Do not write anything negative about their country or government.
- + Please do not mention Open Doors or your home address. Do not include money or other gifts.
- + Hand-drawn items or notes from children can bring great encouragement as well.
