History of Valentine's Day

A brief look at the origin of Valentine's Day reveals a most curious fact. Its patron Valentine, for whom the day is named, had nothing to do with the ancient festival celebrated on February 14th. In order to "Christianize" all people and keep law and order, the "Holy Roman Empire" allowed the Romans to keep most of their pagan observances and simply renamed them. A martyred saint of God, Valentine, was honored on the church calendar on the same day in as the festival of "Luper Calia" or wolf-destroyer. It was a riotous time of mischievous joy, idol worship, and paganistic rituals of love lasting for several days. Many of the pagan customs remain today. Cupid, the Roman god of love has become the symbol of Valentine's Day all over the world.
