

Covid Related Topics Q & A

1. Will masks be supplied by the school?
 - a. On The first day of school students will receive anywhere from 3-5 cloth masks. We ask that you wash these once a week. Also, we will provide clips for students to store their mask when they are not wearing them. The school district also has face shields as an alternative face coverings if needed.

2. If my student is in a mask in the classroom and a student in the same classroom is Covid-19 positive will my student be required to go home?
 - a. The mask will help prevent this issue, but we are unable to guarantee what will take place. Use of masks or face coverings is one factor Two Rivers Health Department will use when contract tracing and making a decision about who needs to be quarantined. At this time we are not certain who will be in contact with you in regards to quarantine or isolation. It could come from Two Rivers, CDC, or an administrator at the school district.

3. What will happen if my student does not wear a mask?
 - a. If masks are required to be worn this will be treated like any other school policy violation. It will be addressed as needed. Students wearing masks may be one way for us to help keep our doors open. Our goal is to have students in the building and by wearing a mask that helps those chances.

4. What happens if a student tests positive for COVID-19?
 - a. If a student has tested positive for Covid-19 they will need to follow what TRHD has informed them to do or the CDC. Once they are cleared they will be able to come back to school.

5. If my student has to quarantine will they be required to attend class digitally?
 - a. Yes, we will ask that they attend digitally. This will look a little different depending on the grade level of your child. It will most likely be in accordance with a normal school day at home. We will utilize the ability of zoom to try and help while students are being quarantined.

6. Where can I pick up my student(s) after school?
 - a. We ask that parents wait for your child outside the building in the front lawn area. K-4 Staff will escort their classes outside at our dismissal time. Staff will remain with the students under the awning, while waiting for students to be picked up.
