

Team and individual performances at the 'Southern' Cross Country Champs.

The Southern Committee was set up by the Amateur Athletic Association (AAA) in 1883 as a counterpart to the Northern Counties Athletic Association (NCAA) and the Midland Counties Amateur Athletic Association (MCAAA) and it served as an area association of the AAA. In 1961, the Southern Counties Amateur Athletic Association was formed and was put on the same footing as the MCAAA and the NCAA. In 1991, the SCAAA amalgamated with the Southern Counties Women's Amateur Athletic Association (SCWAAA, founded in 1930) to form the South of England Athletic Association.

Before the First World War it was the Belgrave custom not to send a team to the 'Southern' unless the club had placed highly in the South of the Thames Championship – 4th was stipulated in 1908.

While other championship events have seen the race distance reduced over the years, the organisers of the 'Southern' have doggedly stuck to the traditional 'old fashioned' cross country distance of ten miles, and subsequently 15 kilometres. During lean years of the 1980s, '90s and even into the new millennium, by which time Belgrave's other distance teams were flourishing, it proved to be very difficult to gather at least six men who were inclined to tackle this distance on the country; ironically this was when the club had some truly world class runners although, admittedly, they tended to be mostly focused on the shorter middle-distance events.

Similarly to the 'National', there was originally a limit on the number of runners allowed to be entered and then race. We believe that twelve were allowed to take part until sometime after 1990 when the limit was removed and as a result scoring places and team scores became greatly inflated.

The runners eventually covered some twelve miles before arriving at the finish where Belgrave appeared to have six men in the first twelve. Like most other clubs Belgrave did not enter the re-run some weeks later when only 32 individuals from four teams took part. Belgrave 'scorers' in the voided race were: J.Ginty, P.Parker, D.Patience, C.T.Carter, A.W.Penny, H.W.Shields.
