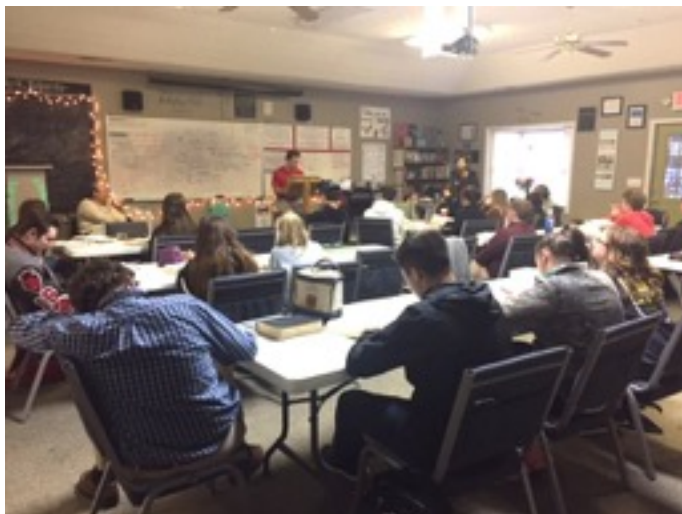

Before our February break, students participated in a debate where they were broken up into 2 groups and discussed the accuracy and truth of the Bible. The purpose of this lesson was to provide students with the tools needed to firmly defend their faith. Each student participated and provided great questions and answers; after each section, we discussed how we could effectively speak to those who may not be believers and answered the most important question, 'Who will I put my faith in?' After our 3rd block debate, with the evidence being overwhelming, we had a student pray to receive Christ as his Savior!!
