Adult Sunday School Offerings

Sunday School Classes for all ages invite you to join them at 10:00 a.m., unless otherwise noted, each Sunday morning.

Contemporary Christians — A group of mature singles and couples. Topic led but with discussion with respectful open and candid participation. Our goal is not to debate, but to discuss the experiences brought to the table. This Fall we will be using an in-depth study on the parables of Jesus Christ using The Parables of Jesus Christ explained by John Clowes. We will be discovering the meaning of each one and then discussing the meanings as they relate to the present day. We will also discuss how each one impacts today's Christian. We cover topics that deal with living the Christian life as we face controversy from domestic and foreign sources.

Discovery Class — Composed of somewhat mature couples and singles who enjoy discussion. We hope that every person will want to participate in the class; therefore, discussion is encouraged and greatly appreciated. We are continuing our study of the book of Acts This winter we will complete an eight-week study on the Sermon on the Mount.

Everyman's Bible Class — An all men's class of every age. We love to start the class with singing at 9:45 a.m. before delving into the Bible lesson. We use The Present Word, a Presbyterian curriculum resource. Through the exploration of biblical text, we invite you into a deepened relationship with God. The Present Word engages participants in an experiential style of learning—connecting faith and life.

FUSE — A class of young adults, singles and couples, 20's thru 40's, who will be studying books and lessons chosen as a group. It is taught by teachers with a heart for this age group, and wisdom and life experiences to share. This Fall we will be using the video series *All the Places to Go* by John Ortberg.

New Horizons — Mostly of disciples in their 40's and 50's, we laugh a lot and learn a lot as we use life experiences to grow in faith. We are a discussion based class that studies a mix of topical studies, Christian living, and books of the Bible.

Presbyterians 101 — Offered at various times throughout the year, this class offers new and prospective disciples an understanding of Presbyterian theology and government as well as an opportunity to learn about the programs of this congregation. Times and dates will be printed in the bulletin.

Rumple Bible Class — A mature class for women only. We encourage women of all stages of life to celebrate the fellowship and community of our class. Our lessons are typically Bible studies facilitated by a teacher. We encourage and appreciate discussion by class members.

Sisters in Christ — Another class for ladies only of any age — college students, single or married, younger or older mothers, empty nesters, and grandmothers — looking for inspirational and challenging women's Bible studies. We take our time and dig deep, going beyond routine. The class craves a passionate relationship with Jesus Christ and enjoys conversation among female friends. This Fall we will be studying Priscilla Shirer's, Discerning the Voice of God.

Sojourners — We welcome all people looking for how the historical life and teachings of Jesus translates to our lives today. We typically use video and books to guide group dialog and discernment.

The WORD Class — A class for anyone committed to reading the Bible within two years! Members will be encouraged to take 10-15 minutes each day to read designated scripture and keep a daily journal. The class will keep each other accountable and on Sunday mornings they will discuss what they've read during the week. If you've always wanted to read the entire Bible or have tried several times on your own, this is the class for you.
