

Enter and Work in a Confined Space

Course code: RIIOHS202A / PRMT002

COURSE AIM

This unit covers the entering and working in confined spaces in resources and infrastructure industries. It includes planning and preparing for entry of confined spaces; entry and working in confined spaces, exiting confined spaces and cleaning up. The course covers: plan & prepare for entering and working in confined spaces; enter & work in the confined space; and exit the confined space.

Prerequisites and Co-requisites: There are no prerequisite or co-requisite requirements for this unit of competency.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course, the student will:

- Have knowledge of the requirements, procedures & instructions for entering and working in confined spaces
- Implementation of requirements, procedures and techniques for the safe, effective and efficient completion for entering and working in confined spaces
- Working with others to undertake and complete the entering and working in confined spaces that meet all of the required outcomes
- Consistent timely completion of entering and working in confined spaces that safely, effectively and efficiently meets the required outcomes

COURSE ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed to determine their competency in this unit both theoretically and practically. The theory assessment consists of multiple choice and short answer questions and has a pass grade of 85%. The practical assessment involves students entering a confined space.
