

"Okay, Mom," says Faye. "We'll be back at 4 o'clock."






"Okay," says Tyler. "John, put the anchor in, please," he asks. "Okay," John replies. He puts the anchor into the water.


"Come on, John. Let's get in the water," says Faye.

"I can't see," says Tyler. "The rain's too heavy. We'll


never get back to the marina."


"I'll help to make the shelter, too," says Tyler.


