


ASPEN is also dedicated to supporting victims of sexual assault and violence. At this point in history, it is more important than ever to listen to

Violence can and does happen in all types of relationships. 6) Domestic Violence is a "temporary loss of temper". No. Violence can be anger-based, but it often can also be premeditated. Domestic violence is intentional and is about power and control-statements like "temporary loss of temper" are excuses. 7) "They were asking for it!"/ "They were provoking me!"/"I was drunk." These again, are excuses. There are no excuses for abuse. Don't let statements like these validate violence. No one deserves abuse, period. Abuse is never about a substance, it is about an individual wishing to exert power and control over another. 8) If it's that bad, why don't you leave? It is never that simple. This is victim blaming. It can be extremely difficult to leave an abusive partner, for they may be one's only source of income, or have access to one's children. No story is the same, and reasons for staying or leaving are deeply personal. 9) Domestic Violence is uncommon, and does not affect many people. Untrue. Domestic violence is prevalent on a global scale. 35% of women worldwide are registered to have survived domestic violence, and over half of registered American homicides have been committed by a partner or someone the victim is close to. 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


