“He was accused of
working against Trump
and leaking against
Trump,” said a former
NSC official, speaking on
condition of anonymity
to discuss intelligence
matters. Also, Ciaramella
huddled for “guidance”
with the staff of House
Intelligence Committee
Chairman Adam Schiff,
including former
colleagues also held over
from the Obama era
whom Schiff’s office had
recently recruited from
the NSC. (Schiff is the
lead prosecutor in the
impeachment inquiry.)
