ALSO PLEASE DO NOT WALK ACROSS OR GRAZE YOUR HORSE ON GRASS AREA IN FRONT OF STABLES WHERE SIGNS ARE POSTED.

Warm Up Arena Etiquette

Sometimes, surviving the warm up arena can be more difficult than getting through your test.

Look Up! - Awareness of other horses and riders around you is crucial if you want to avoid accidents (or the odd word of abuse!). Don't stop suddenly without being aware of who is behind you. If you do accidentally happen to cut someone off or force them to halt, a quick "sorry!" is polite.

Avoid Collisions – By passing left shoulder to left shoulder when approaching head on. If you're walking or doing slow work, keep to the inside track/centre of the arena.

Keeping a distance - Try to avoid riding too close to another horse. Just use your common sense - don't ride up another horse's bum, don't pass too close - we're not playing dodgem cars!

Misbehaving Horses - If your horse is having "behavioural problems", please move to the edge of the arena so as not to upset other horses. Likewise, if you see another horse misbehaving, stay away and if you have to ride near it, do so quietly. If a rider falls off or there is a loose horse, you should halt until the situation is under control.

Be considerate of others at all times - Everyone has equal right in the warm up area. Always give way if a collision is likely - even if you're in the "right". Please bear the following in mind:

- **Juniors and beginners** less experienced, may not have much control over there mount, may be intimidated by other riders. Be aware they may unknowingly get in the way, please show some tolerance
- **Young/green horses** inexperienced, easily upset by other horses. Ride quietly around them and keep your distance
- Lateral work always has right of way.

 Above all, use your common sense and make it a safe environment for everyone to enjoy.

ONLY TWO HORSES ALLOWED AT ANY ONE TIME IN INDOOR WARM UP AREA

Conditions of Entry:

- 1. This event will be conducted under current EA rules as amended. (www.equestrian.org.au)
- 2. Other acceptable conditions for Members Day Only are available from the website: www.legs.org.au
- 3. One rider per horse. Change of rider or horse will be allowed up to commencement of class.
- 4. EA now has a no smoking policy. This policy does not allow smoking in the area in the arena, including gear check and in or around the canteen areas.
- 5. Please present to Gear Check at least 10 minutes prior to your draw time. You must be checked in at Gear Check before entering the indoor or outdoor competition areas.
- 6. When you have completed your test please present to Gear check upon leaving the competition area.
- 7. Please be prepared to ride early in the event of scratchings.
- 8. Refunds of entry fees will be given after close of entries on vet/medical certificate being produced within 7 days of the said competition. In the case of cancellation, \$2 may be retained per rider by the club.
- 9. Members may bring horses that are not entered for the event but if ridden must not be ridden in competition areas. A Visiting Horse Form and Horse Health Declaration is to be completed and handed into office upon arrival. Both forms can be downloaded from www.legs.org.au
- 15. No pedestrians on the grassed area (unless calling)
- 16. No uncovered footwear in competition areas (ie main ring, warm up areas, gear check)
- 17. Any horses standing around waiting, should do so on the track, not accumulate around arena entrances and in the warm up area.
- 18. Designated lunging area grassed area below tennis courts. No lunging in competition/warm up area
- 19. Bridle numbers must be displayed on both sides of either bridle or saddlecloth before going through gear check. If you have been allocated a new number and don't already have your own set a printed set will be available for collection at the office. *No bridle number no ride*.
- 20. Stallions must be stabled and not tied to trucks or floats. All stallions must wear green discs or green bridle numbers as per EA stallion guidelines. For further information please refer to www.equestrian.org.au

GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION.

Casual attire is the dress of the day – any coloured jods with short or long sleeve polo shirt, (sleeveless shirts and collarless tees are not acceptable). Why not purchase a club shirt to wear – available short sleeve polo \$30 or long sleeve rugby \$50, order at membership@legs.org.au (LEGs caps can also be ordered for \$15). Of course, if you wish to wear a coat and tie, you can. Horses can go casual as well; they do not need to be plaited. Stock saddles will be accepted but must be worn with two point girth.

Dogs: Dogs on the ground are not the preferred option. If present they must be on a leash and under complete control at all times. They are not allowed in the canteen or competition areas (including the showground and grandstand) if owners or riders have dogs in these areas you will be asked to leave the area and may entail **elimination.**

Camping and Accommodation: \$15/night both powered and unpowered sites are available. These are not allocated and are on a first in basis.

Stabling: Available at cost of \$20 per day for LEGs members on our member's days. Stables must be very well cleaned (including removal of feed stuffs, manure and wet patches) prior to leaving otherwise rider will be charged a \$50 cleaning fee charged by the Gatton Indoor Centre Management (this is not a LEGs fee). For larger events a \$50 bond is normally charged however this has been waived for our member's days. No temporary overnight yards of any kind will be allowed.

PLEASE PRESENT TO OFFICE TO SIGN IN FOR YOUR JOB SO WE KNOW YOU HAVE ARRIVED. IF NOT SIGNED OFF THEN YOUR NEXT RIDE WILL BE FORFEITED.

THIS DECISION WAS PREVIOUSLY DECIDED AT THE CLUB'S JUNE 2015 GENERAL MEETING.

Biosecurity Recommendations for Competitors

Primary responsibility for biosecurity at horse events lies with the horse owners and competitors long before the event takes place.

Practise good biosecurity

- Practise good hygiene and decontaminate equipment thoroughly.
- Do not share equipment, including food and water containers, between horses.
- Avoid use of communal water troughs.
- If using communal hoses, avoid touching buckets when filling with water to avoid spreading disease from bucket to bucket.

Monitor horse health

- Do not take sick horses to an event.
- Notify an event official if a horse is suspected of being sick.
- Isolate the sick horse and seek veterinary advice.
- Isolate any equipment that has been in contact with the sick horse.
