CHAMPION OPEN SHOW HUNTER HACK ELIGIBLE FOR SUPREME SHOW HUNTER HACK

Conditions of Entry:

- *A rider may ride more than one horse, however, it will be at judge's discretion if classes are to be held to wait for competitors.*
- *This event is conducted under current EA Rules as amended 1st June 2014, all riders must either be an EA Member (current membership card to be presented at time of nominating) or a current full or temporary financial member of LEGs. A temporary day membership of LEGs is available for a \$5 fee payable on the day at time of nominating.*
- *No stallions permitted.*
- *Judges decision is final. Any disputes to be placed with a \$50 dispute fee which will be refunded if the dispute is upheld. Any abuse towards judges or stewards will result in instant elimination for the rest of the day.*
- *The OC reserves the right to amend the program or adjust age groups. Led Line & Beginner riders will not be eligible for Supreme Hack of Show.*
- *Ponies 12.2 & over may be ridden by rider of any age provided the pony is deemed fit to carry the rider.*
- *Classes may be divided or combined at judge's discretion.*
- *HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS MUST BE PRESENTED AT TIME OF NOMINATING ON THE DAY.*
- ***Attire - Neat and Tidy Polo Shirt (short or long sleeve) with Collar (no jackets, ties, button up shirts or vests). All other show gear allowed. So bring your BLING!***

Class Definitions:

Maiden – A horse or pony that has never won a first placing at an open hack day or agricultural show.

Novice – A horse or pony that has never won a champion at an open hack day or agricultural show.

Open – Open to all horses and ponies.

Pleasure - A horse or pony to be ridden in a plain bit with no whip or spurs.

Beginner – Genuine beginner riders only. Open to all ages, rider not to have won a placing at an agricultural or hack show, not eligible to compete in lead line

Show Hunter Classes - Horses cannot compete in both the hack and show hunter classes. Show Hunters should have more bone and substance than a show horse and be suitable for carrying the rider across country. Plain brow bands, no ribbons.

GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION

Dogs: Dogs on the ground are not the preferred option. If present they must be on a leash and under complete control at all times. They are not allowed in the canteen or competition areas (including the showground and grandstand) if owners or riders have dogs in these areas you will be asked to leave the area and may entail **elimination.**

Camping and Accommodation: \$15/night both powered and unpowered sites are available. These are not allocated and are on a first in basis.

Stabling: Available at cost of \$25 per day. Upon payment of this fee at the show office a stable will be opened for you. Stables must be very well cleaned (including removal of feed stuffs, manure and wet patches) prior to leaving otherwise rider will be charged a \$50 cleaning fee charged by the Gatton Indoor Centre Management (this is not a LEGs fee). No temporary overnight yards of any kind will be allowed.

Biosecurity Recommendations for Competitors

Primary responsibility for biosecurity at horse events lies with the horse owners and competitors long before the event takes place.

- **Practise good biosecurity**
 - Practise good hygiene and decontaminate equipment thoroughly.
 - Do not share equipment, including food and water containers, between horses.
 - Avoid use of communal water troughs.
 - If using communal hoses, avoid touching buckets when filling with water to avoid spreading disease from bucket to bucket.

- **Monitor horse health**
 - *Do not take sick horses to an event.*
 - Notify an event official if a horse is suspected of being sick.
 - Isolate the sick horse and seek veterinary advice.
 - Isolate any equipment that has been in contact with the sick horse.
