High Point Award System

- Points are awarded based on rider & horse combination. The rider must be a current financial LEG member and horse to be owned by either the rider or another current financial LEG member to be an eligible High Point Leader board combination
- 2. High Point prizes are awarded at levels Preparatory to Advanced
- 3. Combinations must compete at a minimum of three (3) LEG members competitions to accrue points and qualify for the overall championship of that level
- 4. Points are awarded from 1^{st} to 10^{th} place $(1^{st} = 10pts to <math>10^{th} = 1pt)$

- 5. Combinations are not restricted to accruing points at one level. Combinations will accrue points for all placings in all tests ridden. Combinations that compete across levels throughout the year are eligible to win the overall championship for that level should their points accrual be sufficient not withstanding rule 10.
- 6. Combination is restricted to 2 tests per event, ie: 1 test at Novice and 1 test at Elementary. Two (2) tests will be provided for all levels at each members competition.
- 7. All combinations that accrue points at LEG competitions will have progressive scores appear on the appropriate leaderboards at that test level. Once a combination has competed at three Members Comps, the leaderboard will indicate that combination has qualified for the award.

- 8. There is no minimum percentage requirement to accrue points on the leader board
- 9. Highpoints are awarded in three categories for Preparatory, Preliminary and Novice Junior, Senior & Master with no separation for Elementary, Medium and Advanced

- 10. Whilst a combination may accrue sufficient points to win a level champion, the level champion will not be awarded in consecutive years, I.e. a combination can win *Level* Champion 2015 and 2017 but is ineligible to win *Level* champion in 2016. In the event a combination accrues sufficient points to win level champion on a consecutive year, the champion will be awarded to the second place getter.
- 11. Combinations that compete at Preparatory level are eligible to remain in that level until such time they accrue sufficient points to win Champion Preparatory. Should a combination win Preparatory Champion, they are ineligible to compete in Preparatory level in subsequent years.

Non-Leaderboard Awards:

The **LEG Award for Sportmanship and Service** to the LEGs community. Nominated throughout the year by members and committee through a ballot system at events and via email. Non-riding members eligible for award. Ballots tallied and overall winner decided by committee and presented at end of year celebrations (*Embroidered Chair*)

The **LEG Committee Award** recognises outstanding members and their contributions to the LEG community and awarded at the discression of the committee. Presented at end of year celebrations (*Embroidered Chair*)

The Lockyer Equestrian Group Most Improved Green Horse Award – awarded to a horse starting in its first season of under saddle competition and making the greatest progression over the year – horse to be in the first year of competition. Members to self nominate (notify committee at start of year) a green horse to be eligible for the award. (*Trophy & Embroidered Chair*)
