Rules

ENTRY FEES – The \$25/\$30 wrist band, completed with the rider's name, allows the rider to enter as many classes as they wish on multiple horses if necessary. Classes will not be held up should a rider be competing two horses in the same class. The \$15 per test fee for dressage is a separate charge. All nominations must be paid at the nominations booth and provided with a current horse health declaration form. New and returning LEG members will be required to have their membership completed and financial prior to competition. All non-LEG but EA members are required to exhibit membership prior to competition.

LEG SIGN ON: This event co-insides with the Lockyer Equestrian Group Sign on Day. Any non-LEG member that competes on the day and wishes to join the club will have the \$5 new members fee waived. Membership Fees are \$60 + \$5 new member fee.

NEWCOMER – restricted to horses that have not experienced under-saddle competition of any nature prior to 1 July 2015

MAIDEN – has not won a first place at any agricultural show or hack day

NOVICE – has not won a first or champion open at any other Royal, Agricultural show or hack day

HUNTER – A riding horse that demonstrates more substance than a show horse and is expected to demonstrate the ability to provide a smooth, even ride and reliable temperament. Mounts to be exhibited in plain browbands (no ribbon/bling brow bands). Riders must exhibit their mounts as either hunter or hack not both.

PONIES – adults are eligible to ride in the Pony Hack ring.

NO DOGS – In the interests of safety and in respect of the Gatton showground, we must advise that no dogs are allowed on the grounds.

CONDUCT: LEG committee and ring attendants are all volunteers to the club and the hack show. Please respect that some of these volunteers have never attended an event of this nature before nor have they stewarded. Please be patient and polite whilst attending our event.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: LEG upholds that it is the rider's responsibility to be ready for their class and aware of where the judge is up to in the program. LEG committee/ring stewards will make a maximum of 2 announcements for each class, riders forfeit their nominations should they miss these calls and subsequent judging. Classes will not be held up for riders running late or changing mounts.

WARM UP ARENA: LEG have provided a specific area to warm up only work your horses in this designated area. Only persons mounted on a horse or handler of a horse may enter this warm up area. All coaches and spectators must remain outside the warm-up area.

BEGINNERS RING: This ring has been provided to allow riders **new** to the sport of Show Horse an opportunity to compete without the experience or the level of presentation of the open show horse arena. It is expected that competitors in this arena are inexperienced in all ridden disciplines and not competitors in other fields but new to show horse. Horses competing in the beginners ring are not eligible to compete in the open competition. Horses in this ring are not required to be plaited. Competitors must not have competed at any more than 1 Open Agricultural Show or 2 Hack shows.

APPAREL: this is a T-shirt hack day. ALL riders must wear protective headgear to the current Australian Standard with the retaining chin strap fastened at all times. Riders are required to be suitably turned in light coloured jodhpurs with a collared and sleeved shirt. Mounts are required to be turned out in accordance with show horse presentation inclusive of plaiting. For safety reasons, ALL riders must wear suitable riding boots that are heeled and soled, with little or no tread, at all times when riding at EA events.

PROTESTS: LEG respect the judge's decision and uphold that the **judge's decision is final**. All protests are to be made in writing addressed to the LEG President and committee with a fee of \$50 within 30mins of the event/class in question. Nominated fee is forfeited should the decision be upheld.

CLASSIFICATION: competitors must choose between competing as an open or hunter, not both.

EA RULES: It is the responsibility of all riders/owners/lessee/competitors to be familiar with and aware of all Equestrian Australia rules which govern this sport. For example; the constitution, by-law and policies consist of, but are not limited to: Codes of Conduct, Equine Anti-Doping and Medication Control Regulations.

HORSE HEALTH: It is a requirement of the organising committee that competitors complete a horse health declaration and supply at nomination

2 RING CIRCUS: Additional open classes have been provided. Champion winners from the first round of open classes are not eligible to compete in the following round awards of open classes. Champions from all open classes are eligible to compete for the Supreme Champion of that class (ie Champion Open show horse from each ring is eligible for Supreme Show Hack)

DRESSAGE: the dressage classes are ridden under the current EA Dressage Rules. Tests are offered for Preparatory, Preliminary and Novice. Competitors must nominate for their chosen dressage test(s) (limit of 2 per rider) and can ride their chosen tests at anytime during the day. It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure they do not clash their dressage and show horse classes.

Dressage

Competitors nominate at the beginning of the day for their preferred level. Nominations will be taken at the secretary's office and must include the required fee. There is a limit of two tests per rider – first in best dressed.

Tests will be ridden in the indoor arena.

Riders are to present at the judge's desk when the previous rider has left the arena of competition and the judge is ready to commence the judging the next test. Competitors have 1 minute to enter the dressage arena after the judge sounds the bell to commence. Test callers are allowed.

Placings will be awarded at the completion of all tests.

Beginners - Ring Four

For genuine beginner riders and their ponies (or galloways) who have not competed at more than 2 open agricultural shows or 2 hack shows. Ring commences at 9am. Competitors do not need to be plaited for competition in this ring. Competitors in the beginner ring are not eligible to compete in the open rings. The term pony is generalised, bonafide beginner riders are eligible to compete on horses larger than 13hh and under 15hh.
