ENTRY FEES.

Entry Fee: \$15 per test

Maximum of 2 classes per horse per day. Maximum of 4 tests per rider per day.

Each competition is restricted to 35 horses on a "first in basis", receipt of correct entry and payment (preference will be given to horse/rider combinations who have competed at 3 or more members day in 2015). Reserve lists will be maintained, riders on the reserve list at any level that are not offered a ride, will be refunded the full amount for that competition only. Riders who are offered a ride and do not accept, will forgo all entry fees for that competition. This will be enforced at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

COMPETITION DETAILS

Prize Schedule:

Championship Awards

- Champion and Reserve Champion awarded at each level as well as for each division Preparatory to Novice i.e. Senior, Junior, Masters.
- The horse/pony must compete in both classes at that level to be eligible for Championship awards.
- Rosettes/prizes 1st to 6th for every class.

Conditions of Entry:

All riders must nominate a job to help out on the day.

While we endeavour to allocate your preferred job request, this may not always be possible

1. This event will be conducted under current EA rules as amended. (www.equestrian.org.au)
2. Other acceptable conditions for Members Day Only are available from the website: www.legs.org.au
3. **Maximum of 2 classes per horse per day i.e. can only enter 2 classes at one level**
4. **Maximum of 2 horses per rider. Maximum of 4 tests per rider per day.**
5. One rider per horse. Change of rider or horse will be allowed up to 8am 11th October 2015 however qualifying conditions will apply.
6. EA now have a no smoking policy. This policy does not allow smoking in the area in the arena, including gear check and in or around the canteen areas.
7. Please present to Gear Check 10 minutes prior to your draw time.
8. When you have completed your test please present to Gear check upon leaving the competition area.
9. Please be prepared to ride early in the event of scratchings.
10. Masters age 50 and over. Juniors 17 years and under.
11. Refunds will be given after close of entries on vet/medical certificate produced within 7 days of the said competition. In the case of cancellation, \$2 may be retained per rider by the club. Disclaimer must be completed and forwarded with entries.
12. Horse Health Declaration to be accepted together with release and waiver indemnity when entering through www.nominate.com.au. *Please refer to Biosecurity Guidelines – remember DO NOT TAKE SICK HORSES TO AN EVENT.* By accepting this declaration you declare that the horse/s on this entry will only be brought to the event if they are in good health. You will be giving your authorisation for the designated OC Steward to call for veterinary inspection of the horse/s on this entry and in your care should they be showing signs of illness at any time during the course of the event. You also agree to pay any veterinary fees incurred as a result of this.
13. Members may bring horses that are not entered for the event only if a Visiting Horse Form and Horse Health Declaration is completed and handed into office upon arrival. Both forms can be downloaded from www.legs.org.au
14. No pedestrians on the grassed area (unless calling)
15. No uncovered footwear in competition areas (ie main ring, warm up areas, gear check)
16. Any horses standing around waiting, should do so on the track, not accumulate around arena entrances and in the warm up area.
17. Designated lunging area – grassed area below tennis courts. No lunging in competition/warm up area

18. Bridle numbers must be displayed on both sides of either bridle or saddlecloth before going through gear check. If you have been allocated a new number and don't already have your own set a printed set will be available for collection at the office. No bridle number – no ride.
 19. Stallions must be stabled and not tied to trucks or floats. All stallions must wear green discs or green bridle numbers – as per EA stallion guidelines. For further information please refer to www.equestrian.org.au
 20. As an insurance requirement please ensure that your helmet has a current expiry date, as they are now only stamped for a five year period.

GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION.

Formal attire is the dress code for this event – beige/white jods, riding coat, tie/stock.

Dogs: Dogs on the ground are not the preferred option. If present they must be on a leash and under complete control at all times. They are not allowed in the canteen or competition areas (including the showground and grandstand) if owners or riders have dogs in these areas you will be asked to leave the area and may entail **elimination**.

Camping and Accommodation: \$15/night both powered and unpowered sites are available. These are not allocated and are on a first in basis.

Stabling: Available at cost of \$20 per day for LEGs members on our members days. No temporary overnight yards of any kind will be allowed. This is a speedway weekend no horses will be allowed on the grounds until Sunday morning.

All Trucks and Floats are required to enter the Gatton Showgrounds via WOODLANDS DRIVE. (Opposite the golf course and beside the tennis courts)
