Calculations for Dux

(JOH)

I am aware that some Yr 12 students have been asking how the Dux calculations are done.

- The Dux calculations will be done using the GPA from 100 credits over 5 subjects in one year, with a maximum of 24 credits for any one subject.
- Subjects not offering a minimum of 20 credits must offer an optional achievement standard that is made available to all students to complete, before the Dux calculations are done.
- Credits gained from additional subject areas will not be taken into consideration for the Dux calculations but may be used for level endorsement.
- If more than one student gains the same GPA over their top 100 credits, then consideration will be given to the number of E8's that have been awarded. The student with the highest number of E8's will be awarded Dux. If the number of E8's is also the same, then a joint Dux will be awarded.
- The final decision will rest with the SLT.
