Dear Partners,

Effective on July the 01st, 2018, The Government of the Bahamas has increased the Value added Tax (VAT) from 7.5 % to 12 % to all goods and services in the Travel Industry. This mandatory increase will be absorbed by Viva Wyndham Resorts for all reservations made until September the 30th, 2018.

The new tax increase will be charged to all reservations made from October the 01st, 2018 onwards and traveling from December the 28th, 2018 onwards, therefore, if you have already received the contracted rates from December 28, 2018 to December 27, 2019, please be advised that we will be sending revised rates in order to include the new tax increase.

Viva Wyndham Resorts complies with all local government regulations, acts only in the collection of taxes decreed by the government, and does not benefit from taxes or surcharges established by Government authorities.
