Avis Budget Group is introducing some changes to the existing Additional Driver Policy.

Effective immediately, all new bookings will now incur an Additional Driver fee whenever an additional driver is added to any rental taking place in Australia.

The good news is:

- The spouse of the lead driver will not incur this fee*
- The fee is only up to maximum 5 rental days per additional driver.
- Existing bookings will not be affected by this change.

*The 'Spouse' includes someone, of any gender, that is married to or in a relationship with the Lead Driver.



What you need to know:

- Additional Driver fees are outlined below for clarity, and will apply to each individual additional driver with the exception of the lead driver's spouse.
- Charge is \$5.00 AUD/NZD + GST per day, per additional driver
- Max charge of \$25.00 AUD/NZD + GST per additional driver (5 day max charge)

The process of adding and authorising additional drivers has not changed. The applicable paperwork will continue to be provided on collection of the rental vehicle and processed by the Avis or Budget renting location.

Bookings made prior to 01 July will not be affected by this change, and will not incur any Additional Driver fees.

Further to this, a card transaction fee of 1.29% (including GST) has been introduced on rentals in Australia and will apply to all credit and debit transactions.

Harbour Rocks Hotel Sydney - MGallery by Sofitel - Restaurant Refurbishment

Effective immediately, refurbishment works have commenced on the restaurant which is expected to be completed by 24 September 2018. During this time, Scarlett Restaurant will be closed.

There will be drilling, hammering and painting however minimal disruption is expected. The rest of the hotel is operating as usual.

Work will take place from Monday to Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm.



Mantra Club Crocodile, Airlie Beach - Refurbishment

Effective immediately, maintenance works have commenced which is expected to be completed by 16 July 2018. Works will be undertaken on the Atrium roof of the reception area.

During this time, the lobby will be closed off to the public however reception will still be fully operational during the works. There will be hoarding and scaffolding in place throughout the foyer and some noise disruption is expected.

Works will take place from Monday to Friday between 8:30am and 4:30pm.

Palm Cove, QLD

Palm Cove is located in Far North Queensland on the Australian coast. Arlington Reef is the closest section of The Great Barrier Reef to Palm Cove being around 30 km offshore. NZONE Skydive, Queenstown – New Weight Limit Policy

From Derek Melnick, Business Development Manager, NZONE Skydive:

As part of our commitment to making the incredible experience of Tandem Skydiving as accessible as possible to the

widest travel audience we are adapting our Weight Limit policy.

What will the surcharge be?

- Passengers between 95-104.9kgs will have a NZD\$50 surcharge.
- Passengers between 105-115kgs will have a NZD\$75 surcharge.

When will the weight surcharge be introduced?

Please note all existing booking remain unaffected by the above change, the new weight surcharge will only apply to new bookings made from Wednesday 04 July 2018.

How will the weight surcharge be charged?

We will assess all passenger weights at the time of check in and calculate what surcharge is required.

Surcharge payments will need to be made directly by the passenger at check in time.

Is there a new maximum weight?

Yes, our new maximum weight limit is 115kgs/253Lbs.



Why is there a surcharge being charged to passengers over 95kgs/209lbs?

- Tandem Masters must be fit for the job Skydiving is obviously a very physically demanding job for our Tandem Masters, a job which is made harder with every extra kilogram. Only certain Tandem Masters are compatible in size and strength to take customers over the 95kg/209Lbs threshold.
- Like our Tandem Masters, our gear (harnesses, parachutes, etc) are also put under extra stress with every additional kilogram. When your canopy opens, the gear strapped to you that keeps you safe is stretched. The more it is stretched, the sooner it has to be replaced.
- Planes need expensive fuel to fly, and the more weight on board the plane, the thirstier the plane gets, and the more fuel it burns through.
- If a plane load is comprised of heavier customers, we have to shuffle the whole plane around, and sometimes are required to take less passengers on board to keep within our legal operating weight limits.

We are confident that our revised Weight Limit Policy will bring about a great opportunity for growth which we look forward to partnering with you on and kindly ask that you share this policy update with all of your team and any subagents/retailers/wholesalers and tour leaders that you may work with that book our product through you.

Tourism Holdings Limited (THL) – Maui and Britz Minimum Hire Period *From Product Team, AOT NZ*:

THL have advised a new 14 day minimum hire period is now applicable for all new bookings made from 02 July 2018 between 20 December 2018 and 10 January 2019.

Abel Tasman Kayaks, Marahau – Department of Conservation Fee Increase

Please be advised that from 01 August 2018 the Department of Conservation (DOC) has increased their fees for International citizens (non NZ citizens) walking the great walks of New Zealand. As a result rates have now increased for Abel Tasman Kayaks, our team is working on updating our system to reflect these changes.

All forward bookings will be honoured.




Destination Feature – New Zealand

Lake Taupo

Lake Taupo is centrally located in the middle of the North Island, approximately a 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ hour drive from Auckland and a 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ hour drive from Wellington.

Lake Taupo was created nearly two thousand years ago by a volcanic eruption so big it darkened the skies in Europe and China. Visit the Craters of the Moon and you'll see evidence of the lake's fiery birth in the geysers, steaming craters and boiling mud pools. At some of Lake Taupo's beaches, swimmers and paddlers can enjoy warm, geothermal water currents.



Just north of Lake Taupo you'll find New Zealand's most visited attraction, the magnificent Huka Falls, where more than 220,000 litres of water thunder over the cliff face every second. Taupo is a great lake for water-skiing, sailing and kayaking. The Maori rock carvings at Mine Bay, which can only be seen from the water, make for a great boat trip or kayaking excursion. The forests surrounding the lake offer hiking and mountain biking to suit all levels of experience.

But what Lake Taupo is really known for is fishing. The town of Turangi has the largest natural trout fishery in the world; this is the place to cast a line and look for the big one. Turangi also happens to provide a convenient base for exploring Tongariro National Park, whether it be walking the Tongariro Alpine Crossing (New Zealand's most popular day walk) or skiing at Whakapapa and Turoa ski fields.
