Heron Island – Launch Transfer

Effective 03 April 2019, the following update will apply to the launch transfer timetable:

The Heron Islander will depart the Gladstone Marina at 10:00am arriving at Heron Island at approximately 12:15pm on Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Check in at the Gladstone Marina, Bryan Jordan Drive will open at 8:00am with guests having access to their Heron Island Resort room at 2:00pm.

Guests arriving by air via the Gladstone Airport can book a transfer at the time of making their reservation. The transfer service will depart the Gladstone Airport in front of the Airport Arrivals area for the Gladstone Marina at 8:30am and will be available on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Arrival by air into Gladstone Airport is recommended prior to 8:00am.

The Heron Islander will depart Heron Island Resort at 1:15pm arriving back at the Gladstone Marina at approximately 3:30pm. Guests will be required to check out of their room by 9:00am and will have access to a departure lounge with showers available for their use until their departure from Heron Island.

Guests departing by air via the Gladstone Airport can book a transfer at the time of making their reservation. The transfer service will depart the Gladstone Marina at 4:00pm for the Gladstone Airport (dependent on the boat arriving on time) and will be available on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. For departure by air from the Gladstone Airport it is recommended that flights are booked no earlier than 4:45pm.

There are no changes to the scenic transfers to Heron Island. These will continue to operate daily on demand by Helicopter and Seaplane from the Gladstone Airport. Scenic transfers are subject to availability, weather constraints and the Seaplane is subject to tide times.

Hotel Grand Chancellor James Cook, Wellington - Refurbishment

Effective immediately, James Cook Hotel Grand Chancellor has commenced a room refurbishment which is expected to be completed by 2020.

The 200 rooms and suites in their Lambton Wing are being modernised which includes a complete re-fit of the bathrooms, bedrooms and furnishings.

The refurbishment works is carried out between 8:00am to 5:00pm and the works involve drilling, hammering, painting, carpeting, moving furniture, tiling and grouting.

In order to minimise disruption to guests, the hotel will complete the work in stages (3-4 floors at a time), starting from the top floors of the hotel. A buffer floor is also in place to minimise noise. An external construction lift will be used for the workers and building materials. The construction is not expected to impact the hotel's restaurant or conference floor.

Lake Taupo



Beautiful Lake Taupo sits alongside a remarkable triad of volcanoes standing shoulder to shoulder on the Central Plateau. The impressive lake is about the size of Singapore and is more of an inland sea. Lake Taupo was created nearly two thousand years ago by a volcanic eruption so big it darkened the skies in Europe and China. According to Maori legend, the lake is the pulsating heart of Maui's fish (New Zealand's North Island).

The results of its earth shattering creation can be seen everywhere with active volcanoes, spectacular steaming cliffs, geysers, boiling lakes, bubbling mud pools and floating rocks (pumice).

The lakeside town of Taupo provides a base for visitors who love to fish for trout, ski Mount Ruapehu and explore the local geothermal phenomena. Popular Taupo experiences include Huka Falls, geothermal walks, a prawn farm, lake cruises, New Zealand's first public cable Wakeboarding Park and guided kayak expeditions to see the rock carvings at Mine Bay.



Hukafalls Jet

The Huka Falls is regarded as one of New Zealand's most spectacular and most visited natural attractions.

Huka Falls are created by water that has flowed through a wide riverbed around 100 metres wide and four metres deep, that is then confined to a narrow river section about 15 metres in width and 10 metres deep.

At the top of the falls is a set of small waterfalls dropping over about eight metres. However, the most impressive part of the Huka Falls is watching extensive amounts of



water flow over a cliff 11 metres (35 ft) high. The flow over the Huka Falls fluctuates between 32 and 270 cubic metres per second. On average the daily flow over the falls is 160 cubic metres per second. Depending on the flow of water, the height of the falls fluctuates between seven and nine and a half metres.

The unique blue colour of the water at the base of the falls is created by the clear water reflecting the blue light and the air bubbles in the water intensifying the colour further.
