

Jesus claimed to be the Messiah, and He backed up His claim through His authoritative teaching and healing of people.

The Gospel according to
LUKE

Crowds of people, including the religious leaders, came to see and hear Jesus, but not everyone accepted Him as the Messiah. Those who did, put their faith in Him, and they were able to do so through repentance.

The Gospel according to
LUKE

Repentance means to change one's mind, so repentance in relationship to Jesus is to change one's mind from not believing He is the Messiah (Christ) and Son of God to believing that He is.

27 After that He went out and noticed a tax collector named Levi sitting in the tax booth, and He said to him, "Follow Me."




The sacrifices of God are
