IMPLEMENTATION TOUR PRESENTATION

The Valencia implementation tour will introduce the development of a city sustainability project as its main learning objective. The methodology used is based on Problem Based learning where the students will have to reflect and prepare a project for developing the selected sustainability objectives from the range within the SAUNAC project, applied to a Vietnamese city or neighbourhood of their choice.

The academic program presents current state of the art into the sustainability development techniques, collaboration tools and impact assessment methodology which will be incorporated by the students to their Final project for academic assessment. The deliverables will be a written project, and a joint presentation which will be video recorded. All students will be graded in groups according to their performance with a 60% load on the written project, and the remainder 40% based on the video presentation. Rubrics and learning material will be delivered to the students on the intranet for the course.

The program will be carried out at the UPV premises on classroom 2.09 from the Long Life Learning Institute (second floor, building 6G from the map: http://www.upv.es/plano/plano-2d-en.html). Cultural and implementation visits are included on the program for an optimal knowledge acquisition experience.
