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Technology News

This will be year three of our 1:1 Chromebook initiative in the high school. In year one (2015) we were able to obtain Chromebooks (small laptops) for all 9th and 10th graders by way of a grant from EdTechTeam. Last year we added another set of devices for the incoming 9th grade, and the other Chromebooks moved on up with the students. This year we should have Chromebooks for all high school students as we add enough for the new 9th graders and any other newcomers to our high school!

Each high school student must provide a case for his/her Chromebook since the devices go home with students. The case must provide protection for the device. Look for a case that fits an 11.6 inch Chromebook or laptop. They are easily available at Amazon.com and other retailers for a reasonable cost.

During online enrollment, all families encountered numerous forms to read and sign, including **technology forms**. It is easy to lose track of what was in those forms, especially when you read them so long ago. To be sure that students and parents know what is expected regarding technology at all levels and 1:1 Chromebooks in high school, the email with this newsletter also includes copies of the relevant technology forms. Students need to be aware of the expectations that they agreed to when electronically signing those forms, so we encourage families to read them again together and be sure that you understand what is included in the agreements.

News from the Athletic Director

The 2017/18 school year is fast approaching. Please make sure your student athlete has all of the necessary forms completed and to the school office by August 7. Below you will find a list of items needed to make sure you and your athlete are prepared.

- 1. Have a current PIAA physical dated *no earlier* than June 1, 2017.
- Watch the Cougar Athletics video, available August 7, or make it personal and meet with Mr. Yoder for an informational meeting on Monday, August 14, in the school library from 5:00-5:45 PM.
- 3. Pay the sports fee of \$85.00 prior to the athlete's first practice. Please make checks payable to CCS.
- 4. Go to the Athletics Schedule, view practice and game schedules, and sign up for notifications.

Practices begin on August 14 for high school soccer and volleyball. Middle school soccer and volleyball practices begin on August 21. Coaches may use the first 2-4 practices for try-outs. Coaches will announce this at the first practice.
