| Quantity | |

| 1 | ESV student edition Bible |
| 1 | binder - heavy duty, zippered , 3-ring, 1½ in. minimum - 2 in. maximum - square ones do not fit in the chair pockets - regular shape is best |
| 8 | plastic, colored pocket dividers with tabs, Avery is recommended - to be labeled at school |
| 2 pkgs | wide-ruled loose-leaf notebook paper . No spiral notebooks. I store the extra paper for later use |
| 2 | paper folders with pockets and no brads - one is for homework and the other is for storing paper in the student desk |
| 1 pair | headphones or ear buds for computer use. Place in a Ziploc-type plastic bag - label both. Consider investing in good ones that can also be used to block sounds while working on assignments. |
| 2 pkgs (24 total) | #2 pencils - Label each pencil in one box with your child's initials. (use permanent marker or tape) The second box will be stored and shared with students, as needed, throughout the year. Dixon Ticonderoga sharpens best and lasts the longest. No mechanical pencils. |
| 1 | large eraser - white erases the best |
| 1 box | colored pencils (24-36) - map and project work - these may need to be replaced later |
| 1 | dry erase whiteboard marker , thick tip, black, LOW ODOR ONLY - label |
| 1 | whiteboard eraser - label |
| 1 | ballpoint pen - such as Bic stick, blue or green - no black - label |
| 2-3 | highlighters - variety of colors - labeled |
| 1 | art shirt in a Ziploc-type plastic bag - both labeled |
| 1 box | Sandwich bags |
| 1 box | Gallon size bags |
| 2 boxes | tissues - family-sized - for classroom sharing |
