
- Special facts about the surah

#### **Teaching Tips:**

If your younger child has trouble going through the whole book in one sitting, or does not retain all of the information taught, then just focus on the Tafseer pages first (i.e. those that explain the verses of the surah) and save the additional information contained in the Quick Facts, What's Special, Asbaab An-Noozool, and Vocabulary sections\* for later when your child has mastered the Tafseer.

For older or advanced students who need more of a challenge, you can take time to go through all sections and discuss the lesson notes for that section (located at the end of the text). This will make lessons more challenging and provide a deeper understanding of the Tafseer, and Allah knows best.

### Quick Facts about Suratuz-Zalzalah

Suratuz-Zalzalah was revealed in **Makkah.** 

This surah gets its name from the first ayah in which the words **Zoolzeelah**, and **Zilzal** occur. Both words have the same root, which means to shake violently (i.e. earthquake).

Suratuz-Zalzalah is also sometimes called "Suratuz-Zilzaal".

# So what is Suratuz-Zalzalah all about?

Suratuz-Zalzalah is about the things that will happen on Yowmul-Qiyaamah, like the terrible shaking of the Earth, and the tiniest good and bad deeds being counted.



Now let's learn what makes Suratuz-Zalzalah so...



### Suratuz-Zalzalah is so special because ...

It is one of **9 suwaar** (chapters) in the Qur'aan named after **Yowmul-Qiyaamah**, or something that will happen on Yowmul-Qiyaamah. These suwaar are...

- 1. Waaqi'ah (The Event)
- 2. Haaqqah (The Reality)
- 3. Qiyaamah (The Rising of the Dead)
- 4. Takweer (The Overthrowing)
- 5. Infitaar (The Cleaving)
- 6. Inshiqaaq (The Sundering)
- 7. Gaashiyah (The Overwhelming Event)
- 8. Zalzalah (The Earthquake)
- 9. Qaari'ah (The Calamity)

Now that we have learned what is so special about Suratuz-Zalzalah, let's get reads to learn what Suratuz-Zalzalah is all about!

We will start by learning **6 new words** from the Qur'aan.

The more words you know from the Qur'aan, the better you will understand each surah that you learn insha-Allah.

Understanding the Qur'aan is what Allah wants us to do!




