AN ACT for the relief of the Collinsville Plank Road Company.

En force Feb. 15,  
1855.

[SECTION 1.] *Be it enacted by the people of the state of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly, That the Collinsville Plank Road Company organized under the general plank road law of this state be allowed five years from and after the passage of this act within which to complete the construction of their plank road, as contemplated in their articles of association, anything in said general plank road law or any act amendatory thereto or in the proceedings of said company to the contrary notwithstanding.*

This act to be in force from and after the date of its passage.
