## JESUS, THE EVANGELIST (full of good news) WHO CALLS THE LOST




#### **MARK 1:14**

<sup>14</sup> After John was put in prison, Jesus went into Galilee, proclaiming the good news [gospel] of God.


#### **MATTHEW 4:23**
