1. Introduction

The annual program of work guides the SDSN Switzerland activities and is a yearly complement to the SDSN Switzerland organizational principles and concept note.

2. Thematic Priorities

The following topics were prioritized among participants during the 5 May 2017 kick-off meeting and therefore constitute the thematic priorities of SDSN Switzerland:

- Sustainable Consumption and Production (SCP): Reduce the ecological footprint resulting from unsustainable consumption and production processes in Switzerland.
- Finance systems: Encourage sustainable, private and public investment, including funding for international cooperation.
- Governance for sustainable development: Align institutions and governance to Agenda 2030.

Central to the transformative processes are evidence-based, social, economic, technological and institutional innovations developed by the scientific community in conjunction with society itself.
