Pal Temesvari has coached, inspired and tutored countless swimmers and numerous aspiring coaches during the 29 years of coaching in Manitoba. The Head coach of Mid Can Masters and retired Head Coach for Manitoba Marlins, Pal is the epitome of a coach. For his life long commitment to the sport of swimming in 2014 Pal was awarded the first Active for Life Coaching Award by Coaching Manitoba. Pal was the long-time Manitoba Marlins head coach, is fully certified NCCP III coach. He has been part of the Canadian Swim Team coaching at international events including the 2000 Summer Olympics, 1999 and 1995 Pan Am Games, 1996 Summer Olympics, 1995 World Championships and 1994 Commonwealth Games. Pal started he's coaching career in Hungary where he coached many of the top Hungarian swimmers prior to immigrating to Canada. Pal continues coaching with Mid Can Masters Club with no sign of slowing down.
