8.1. **Top 16 Women's and Men's Singles**

8.1.1. Stage 1

Divided into groups depending on the number of entries to play a robin system to decide the group winners.

8.1.2. Stage 2

Top 2 winners from each group to play a knockout system to decide the winners

8.1.3. All matches to be decided by best of 5 games, except semi-finals and final to be best of 7 games.

8.2. **Open Women's and Men's Singles**

8.2.1. Stage 1

Divided into groups depending on the number of entries to play a robin system to decide the group winners.

8.2. Stage 2

Top 2 winners from each group to play a knockout system to decide the winners.

8.2.3. All matches to be decided by best of 5 games, except semi-finals and final to be best of 7 games.

8.3. **Women's and Men's Veteran Singles**

8.3.1. Stage 1

Divided into groups depending on the number of entries to play a robin system to decide the group winners.

8.3.2. Stage 2

Top 2 winners from each group to play a knockout system to decide the winners.

8.3.3. All matches to be decided by best of 5 games.
