SHORT PRESENTATION

Union Red Dragons was founded in 1989 as Austria's first Inline hockey Club at a time when Inline hockey was not very commonly known. Within years Red Dragons became the most successful Team in Austria and always plays at the top of the Austrian Championship. Union Red Dragons visit Givisiez as actual Austrian Veterans Champion; with one exception all previous national Veterans Championship were won. In 2013 the Dragons achieved the title of Vice-Champion at the Veterans European Cup in Copenhagen.

SHORT PRESENTATION

Langnau, a small town south of Zurich, has a long tradition in participating in the sport of Inline-Hockey. Anvil Langnau introduced it to the area in the early 1990s. In 1996, IHC Langnau Stars and Fireballs Langnau were officially founded. Over the next couple of years these clubs played in a league around the lake of Zurich. In 2008, after a very successful ten years of growth locally, IHC Langnau Stars joined the Swiss Inline-Hockey Federation, a step that elevated the club on and off the field to a another level. Within the first three years after joining the Federation, IHC Langnau Stars ascended from the 2nd league into the Swiss National League B. Further developments led to the creation of a second team and a first team for junior players to be founded in 2010. Elsewhere, efforts have been made to improve and refurbish the infrastructure and we were proud to open our own "Sternebeiz" a place for refreshments and food right next to our inline hockey field, a gathering point for visitors where beer and burgers play a major role on match days. Most recently, in 2016 the newly founded Stars Senior Team won the seniors championship in their first season, the best possible reward to celebrate 20 years of emotions at IHC Langnau Stars.
