Beginning Balance Feb.1: \$17,878.74 Ending Balance Feb 28: \$14,988.19

PTA Fund Allocation

Our current projected balance at the end of the year- June 30th \$20,783

We have decided on a rollover budget to begin next year at \$8000

Proposed Spending: \$13,448 to be paid out in May or as individual projects are done -6th grade promotion ceremony: \$600

- -Landscaping (as stipulated by School Mall fundraiser): \$500
- -Playground area/recreation field improvements: \$1600 (as stipulated by Fire Up Your Feet) + and additional \$1400 = \$3000
- -School beautification/banners: \$500
- -Computer cart contribution: \$8248 (past Fun Run earnings for technology)
- -Administration discretionary fund: \$300/semester
